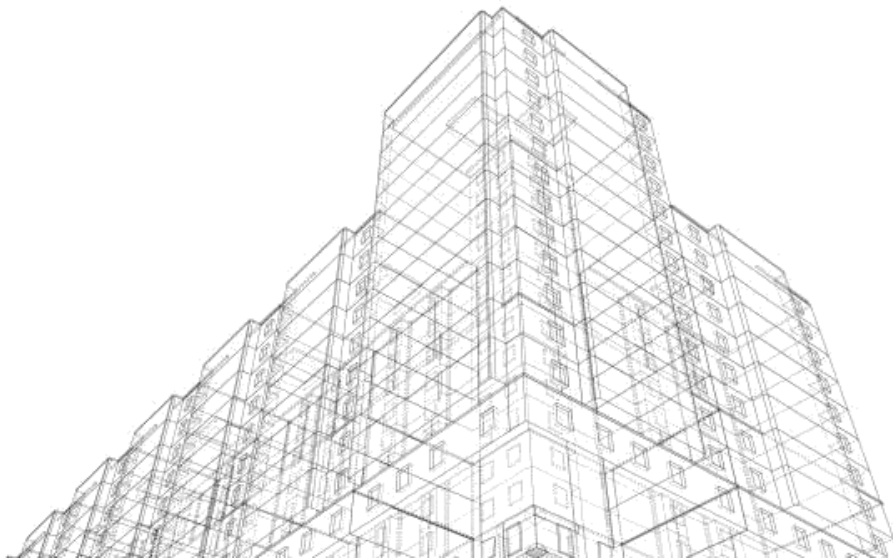

The CDM Regulations (2015) legislation made important changes to the roles and responsibilities for the client, designer, and contractor/principles contractor. The new role of Principle Designer was introduced as a part of the regulations.
