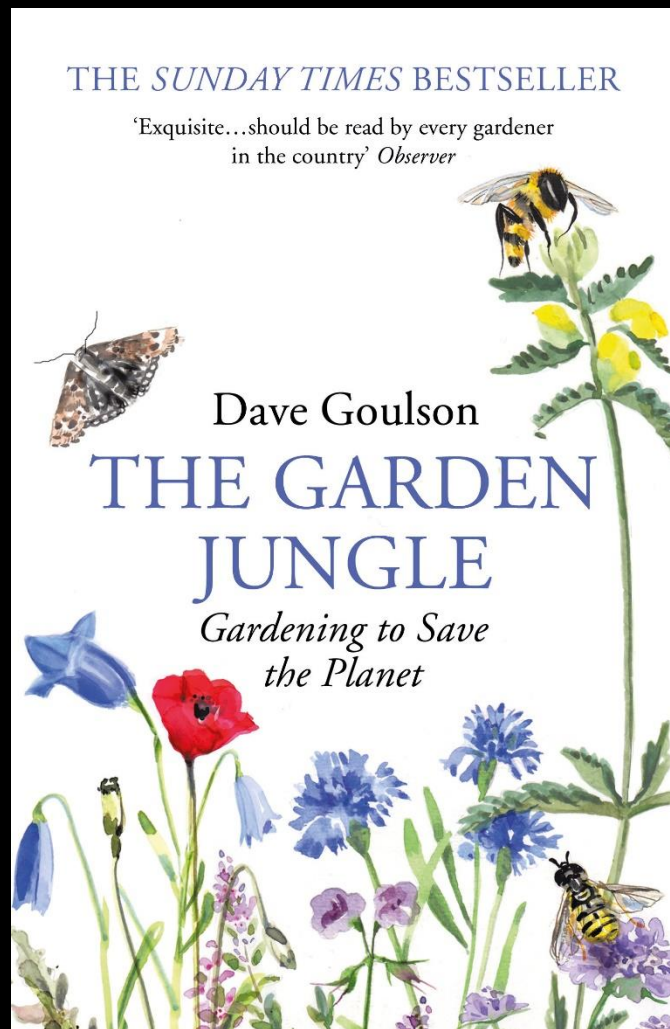

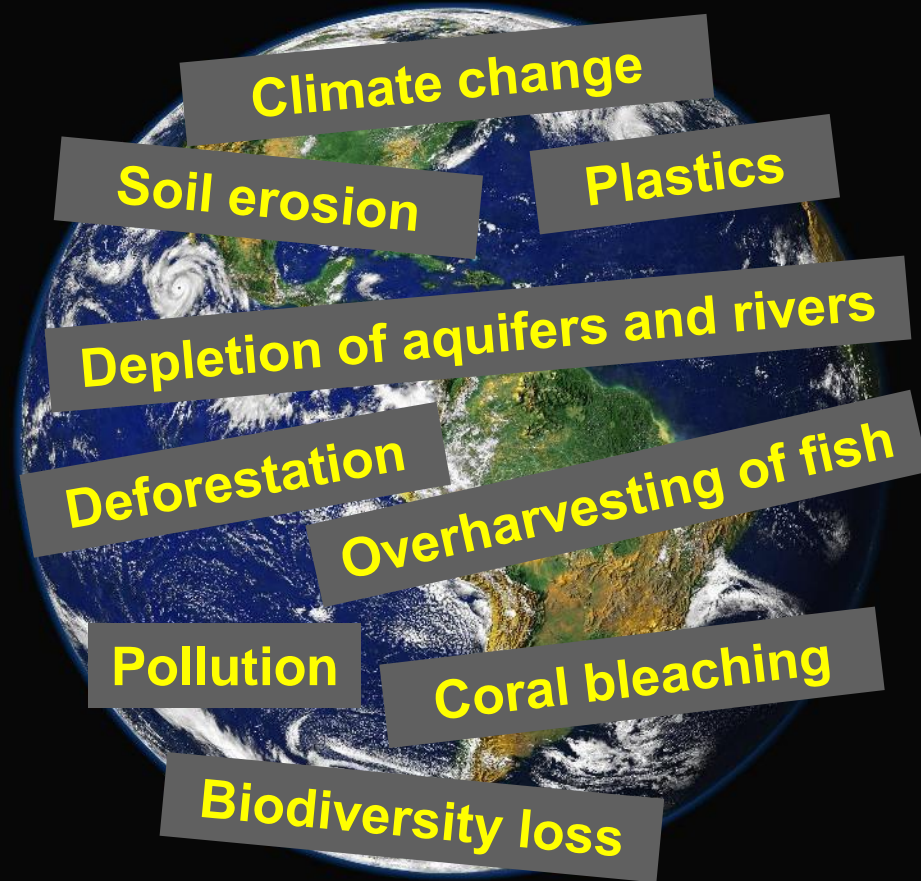

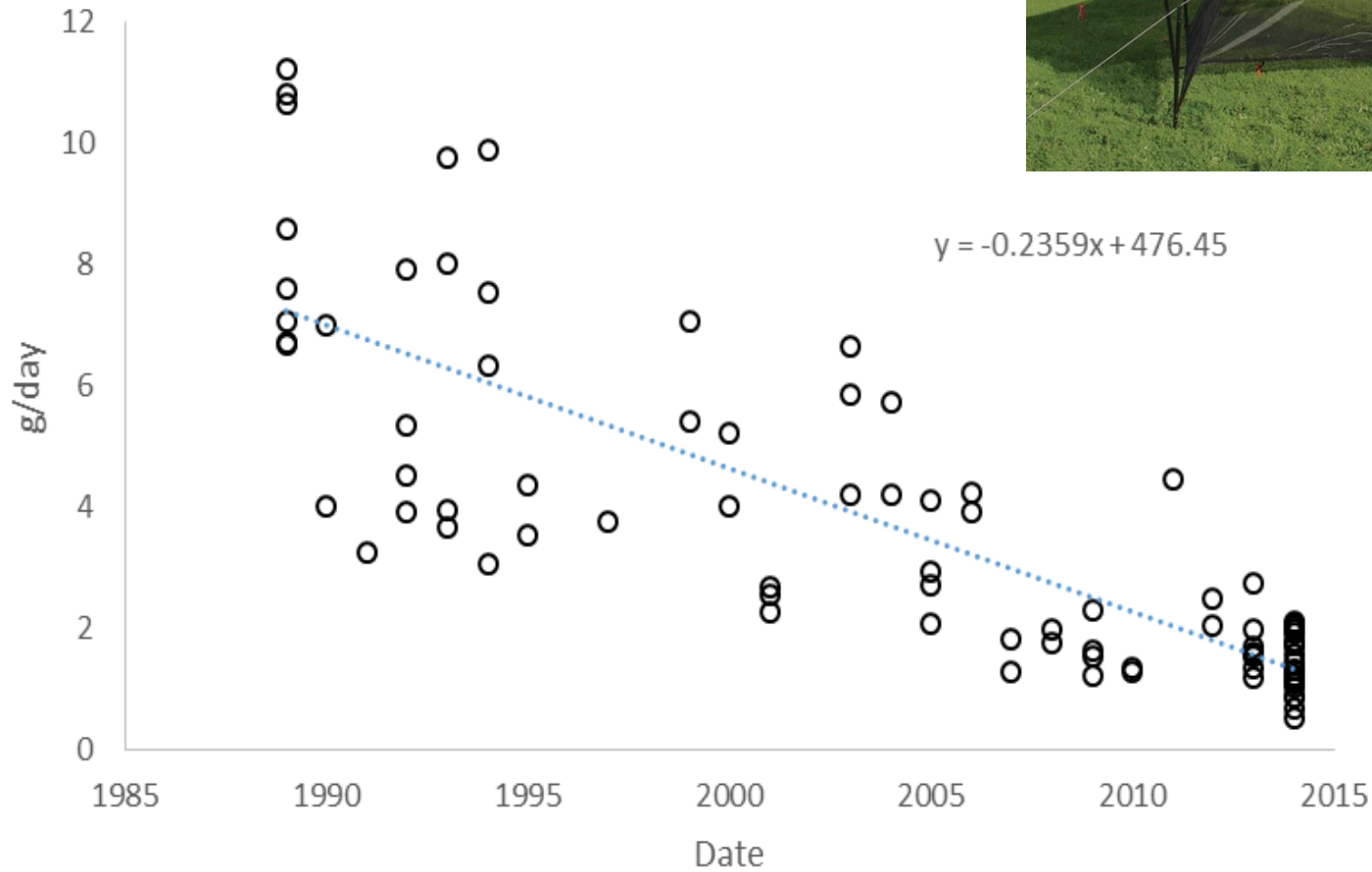




Human population growth

“If all mankind were to disappear, the world would regenerate back to the rich state of equilibrium that existed ten thousand years ago.

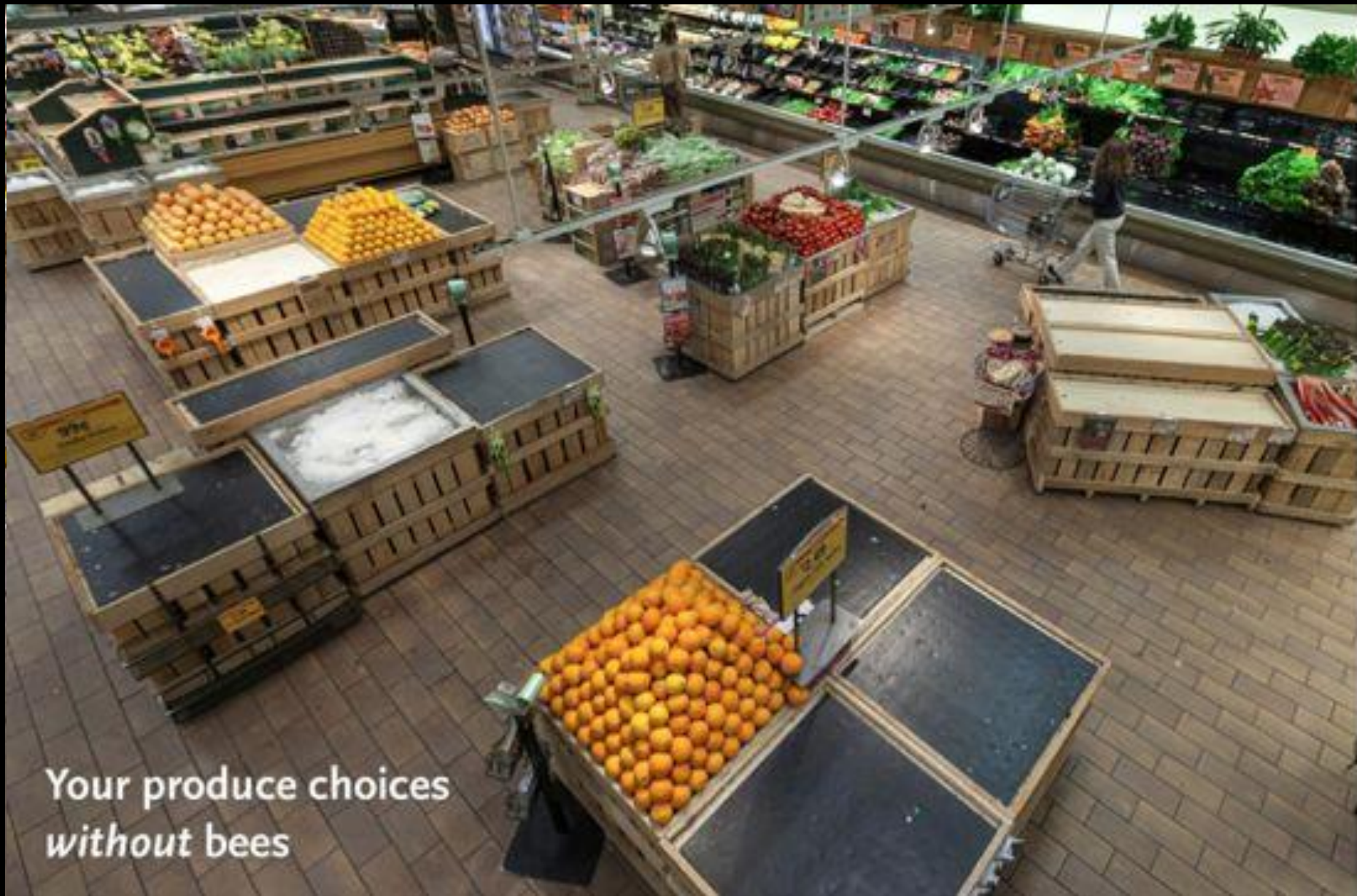
