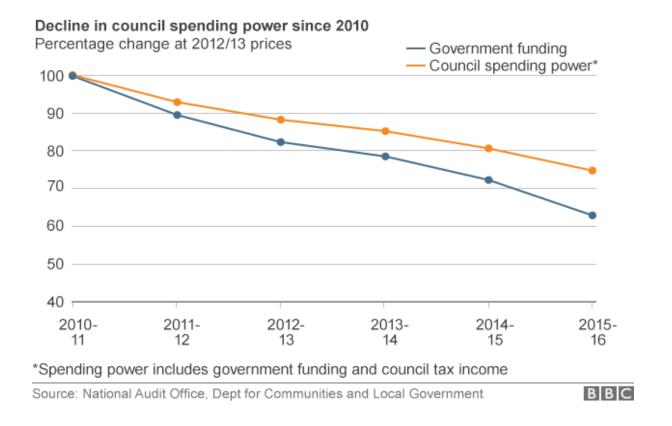

- Challenge culture



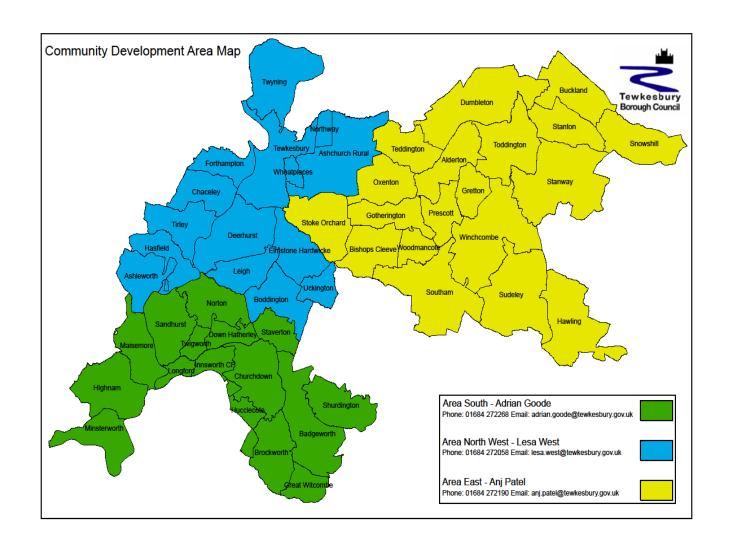
How to support change

Create multi agency response

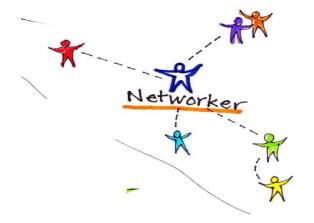

The future will be different

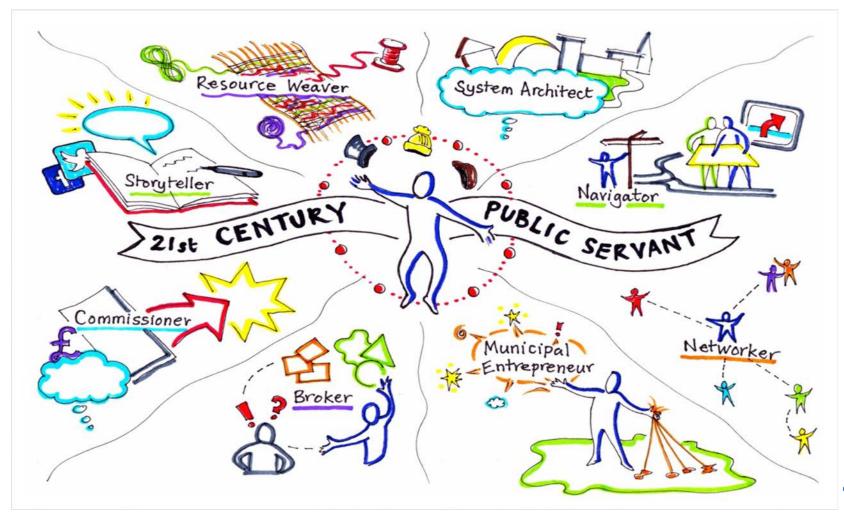
- Multi agency working
