
Derby allotments: Overview and history

- **19** under lease agreements
- 2 directly managed by local authority
- 8 privately owned sites
- 2200 plots (approximately)
- 1890 1915 Industrial growth led to creation of allotments
- 1950's post war Grow your own movement led to second wave of new sites
- Last 10 years Increase in allotment demand led to regeneration of 2 disused sites and 2 new sites




Derby Allotments: Overview and history

1846 – 1901 County Series




1888 – 1915 County Series

1950's 2.5k National Grid




2020 Base Map

Self management model – benefits and risks

Benefits

- Community pride
- Autonomy (financial, rules, decision making)
- Flexibility/Ability to respond quickly
- Access to external funding/fund raising ability
- Volunteering/new skills/training opportunities
- Collaborative working with other organisations/businesses



Self management model – benefits and risks

Risks

- Variable volunteer skills/capabilities/experience
- High turn over of volunteers
- Not enough volunteers
- Inconsistent allotment management
- Liabilities for the allotment associations/trustees
