4. Framework is fully compliant and open to all Public Sector organisations
5. Best value

 4. Hydraulic platform
3. Direct Award (must be significant portion of requirements)
4. Fixed pricing with annual review
5. Supplementary quotations
 1. Delivery / Installation / Servicing & Maintenance
6. Further Competition – all suppliers on lot



Lot 2: Supply of Technology

1. 6 suppliers – Value Cap: £8m
2. Types of Technology
 1. Access control systems
 2. Fill level sensors
 3. Weighing technology
 4. Vehicle routing systems
 5. Other system control technology
3. Direct Award (must be significant portion of requirements)
4. Fixed pricing with annual review
5. Supplementary quotations – non-core products
6. Further Competition – all suppliers on lot



Lot 3: Supply of Vehicles

1. 5 suppliers – Value Cap: £28m
2. Wide variety of vehicles and customisation
3. Further Competition only
4. Must involve all suppliers on lot



Lot 4: Servicing & Maintenance of URS



1. 6 suppliers – Value Cap: £4m
2. Can specify individual requirements
3. Further Competition only
4. Must involve all suppliers on lot
