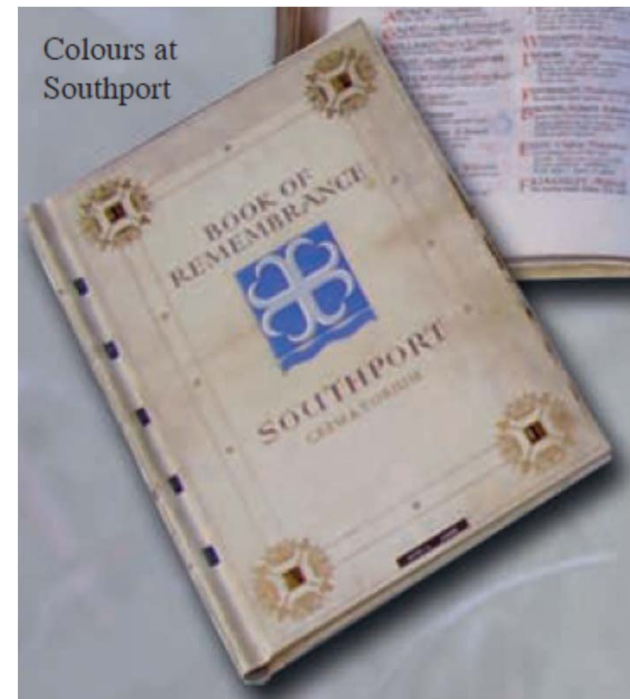

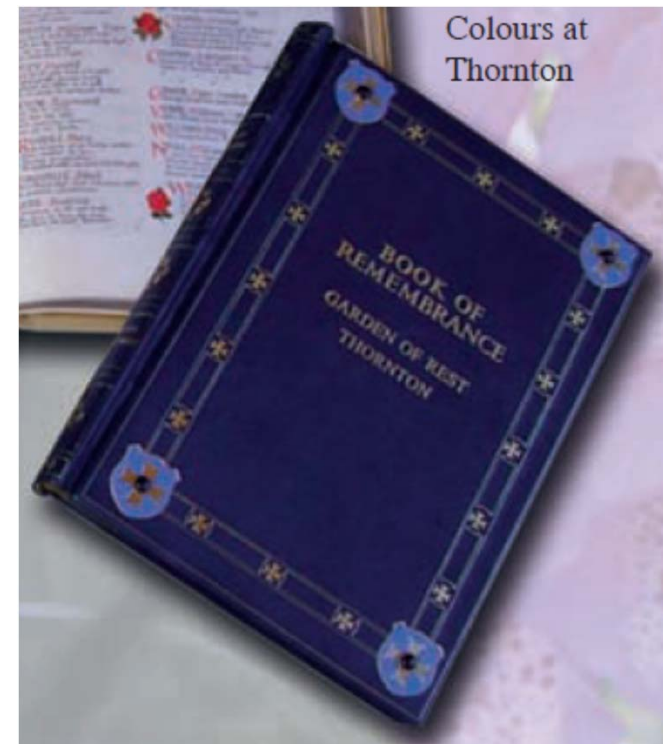

COVID-19 Update: Current Guidance for Attendance at Funerals

Following guidance from the [ICCM](#) and the Federation of Burial and Cremation Authorities we have been advised that only immediate families should attend funerals at this time.

This includes:

- Spouse/Partner;
- Parents/carers;
- Brothers/Sisters and
- Children (and their partners)

We are now advising that a maximum of 20 people should attend burials and cremations at this time.

National expectations for social distancing should be observed at all times.

Mourners should wait outside or in their cars until the funeral is ready to start.

Cremation times will be 30mins long, 20mins in chapel.

-No windows darkened:

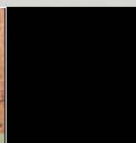
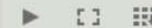
For my own
