Child Poverty



- Prior to Covid-19, an estimated 4.2 million children were living in poverty in the UK, equivalent to 9 children in every classroom of 30.1
- 14% of parents and guardians living with children have experienced food insecurity in the last six months.2
- There are four million people living in these affected households including 2.3 million children.
- This remains higher than pre-Covid-19 levels of 11.5% of households with children.2
- 600,000 more children are in relative poverty compared to 2012.




- Alison Garnham, Chief Executive of Child Poverty Action Group said:

 because it will damage children's well- being, their chances in life and
 the country's economy."

- 86% would like help with food and or money










National Holiday Activity & Food (HAF) Programme

National food Strategy

- Expand eligibility for the Free School Meal scheme to include every child (up to the age of 16) from a household where a parent or guardian is in receipt of Universal Credit or equivalent benefits.
- Extend the Holiday Activity and Food Programme to all areas in England, so that summer holiday support is available to all children in receipt of free school meals.
- Increase the value of Healthy Start vouchers to £4.25 per week, and expand the scheme to every pregnant woman and to all households with children under four where a parent or guardian is in receipt of Universal Credit or equivalent benefits.
