How does it work?

In Stoke there are:

18,000 council properties

15,000 are eligible for solar and battery tech

3,000 remaining can still join and benefit from the scheme



How does it work?

City Council tenants
have been **choosing** to switch to
affordable, renewable energy



How does it work?

Solarplicity assess their property and if suitable, will install **solar panels** on their roof and **battery storage**.

At **no cost** to the landlord or the tenant



How does it work?

There's just **one simple rate** for electricity and gas –

Guaranteed to be lower than the Big 6 average
(always and forever)

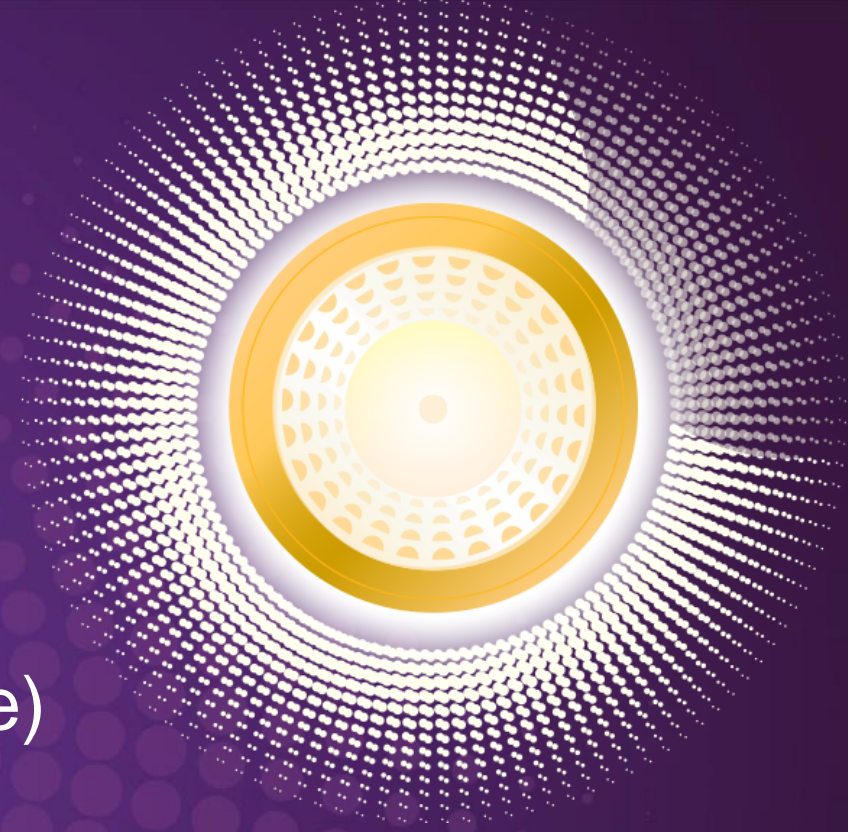

57k SAP Points

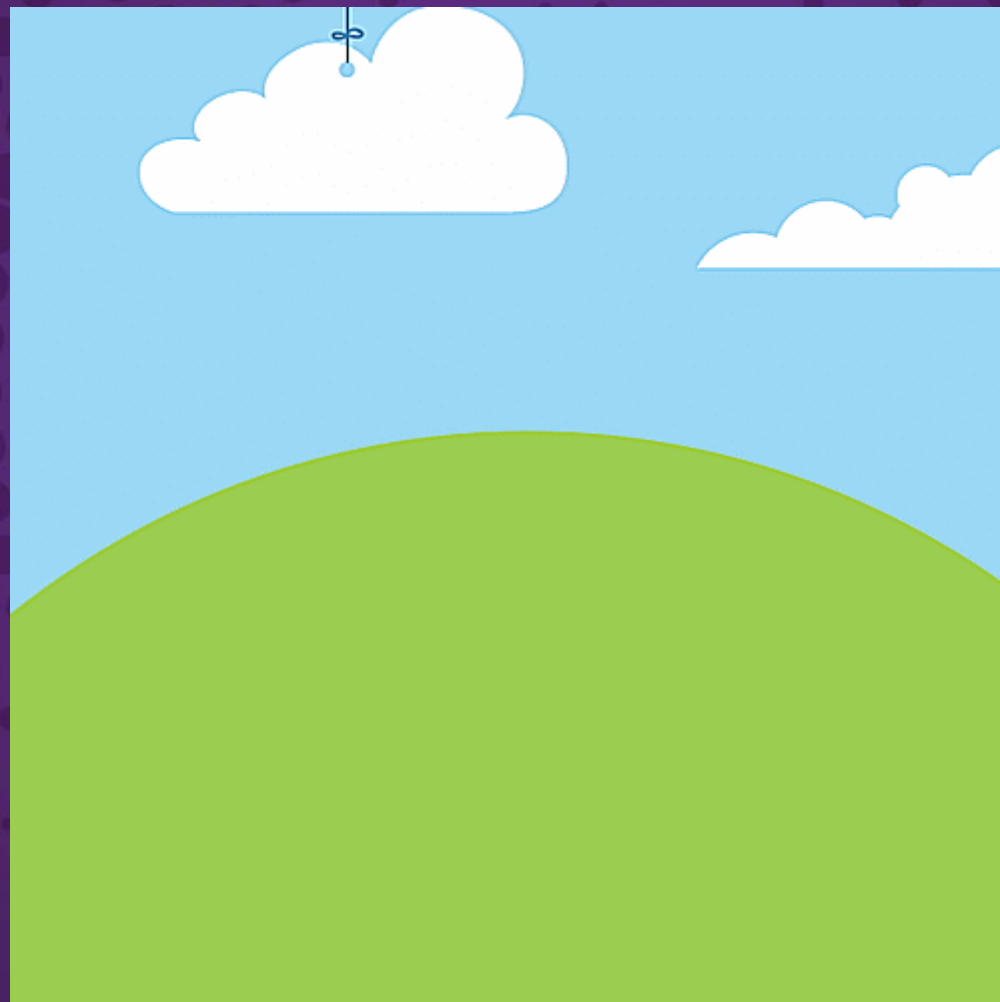

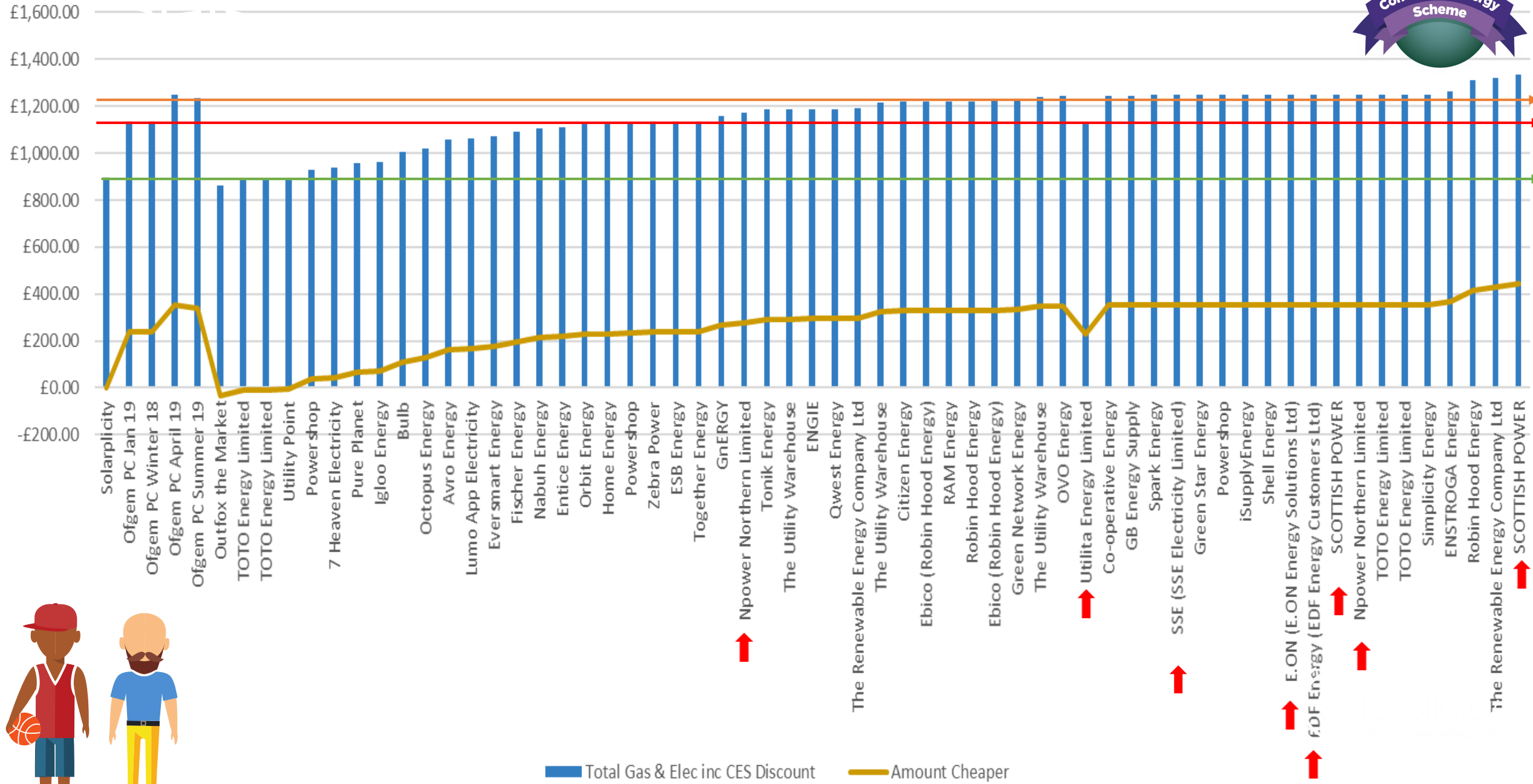
