
### Solar Survey & the UK Solar Summit

### New Salix Funding for Scotland

- Scotland's Public Sector Heat Decarbonisation Fund
- £20 million grant funding available within this financial year under Scotland's Public Sector Heat Decarbonisation Fund which will be delivered by Salix
- The fund allows for applicants to apply for single or multi-year funding to support the delivery of their heat decarbonisation and/or energy efficiency project(s)
- Once applications are received by Salix they will undergo a quality-based assessment and the highest scoring applications will be approved for funding. The time of submission will have no impact on the assessment outcome, provided that the portal is not closed
