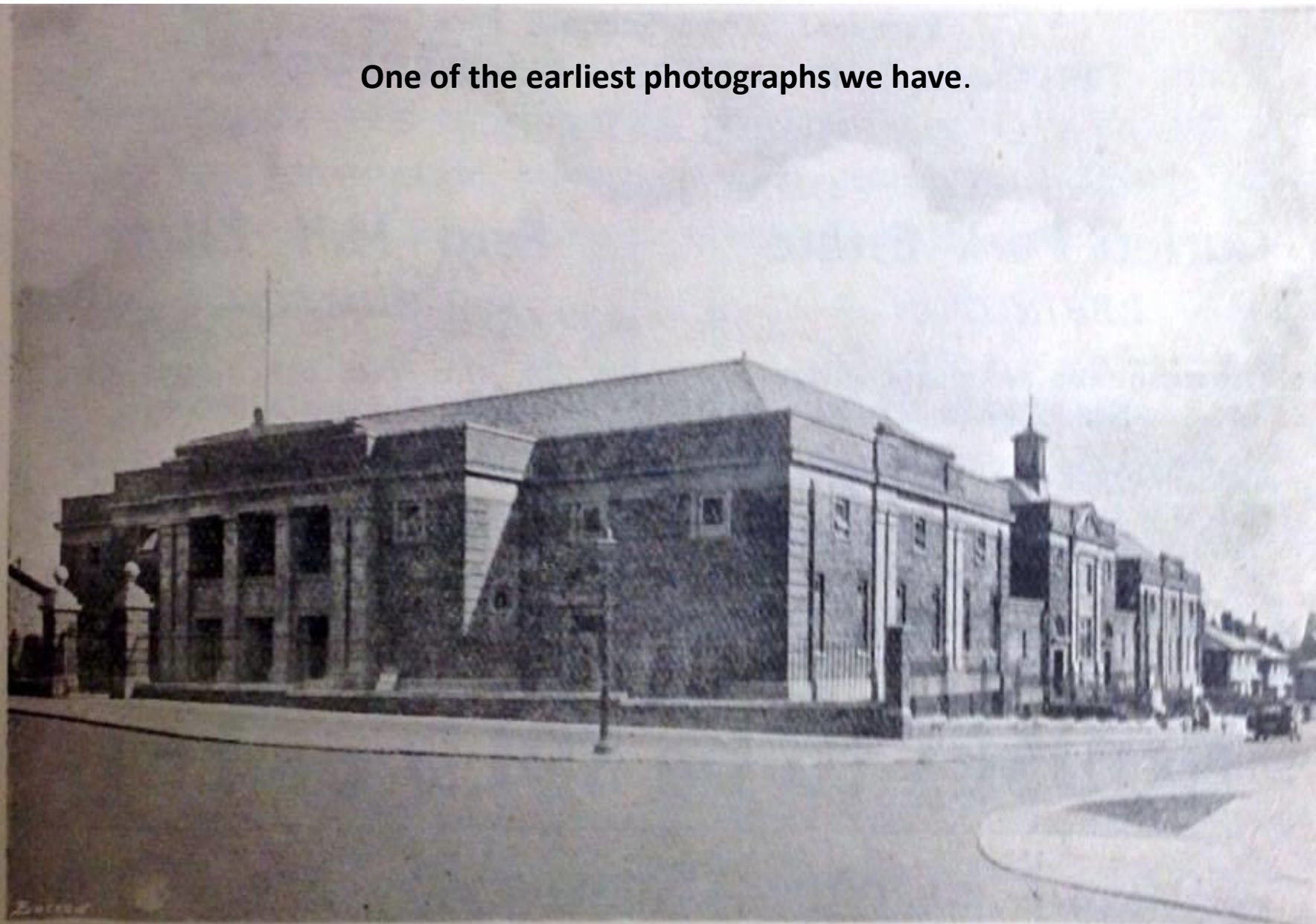


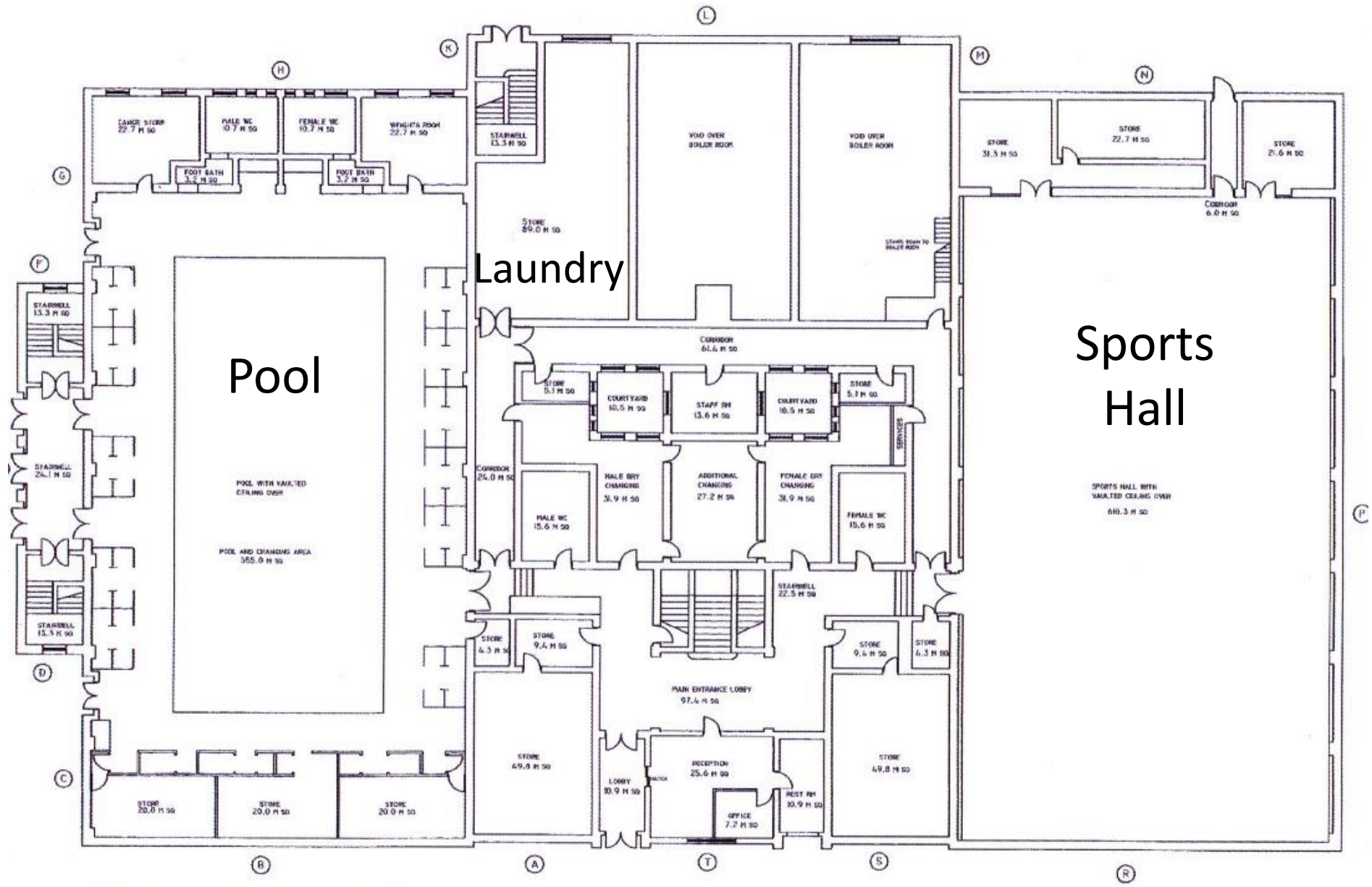

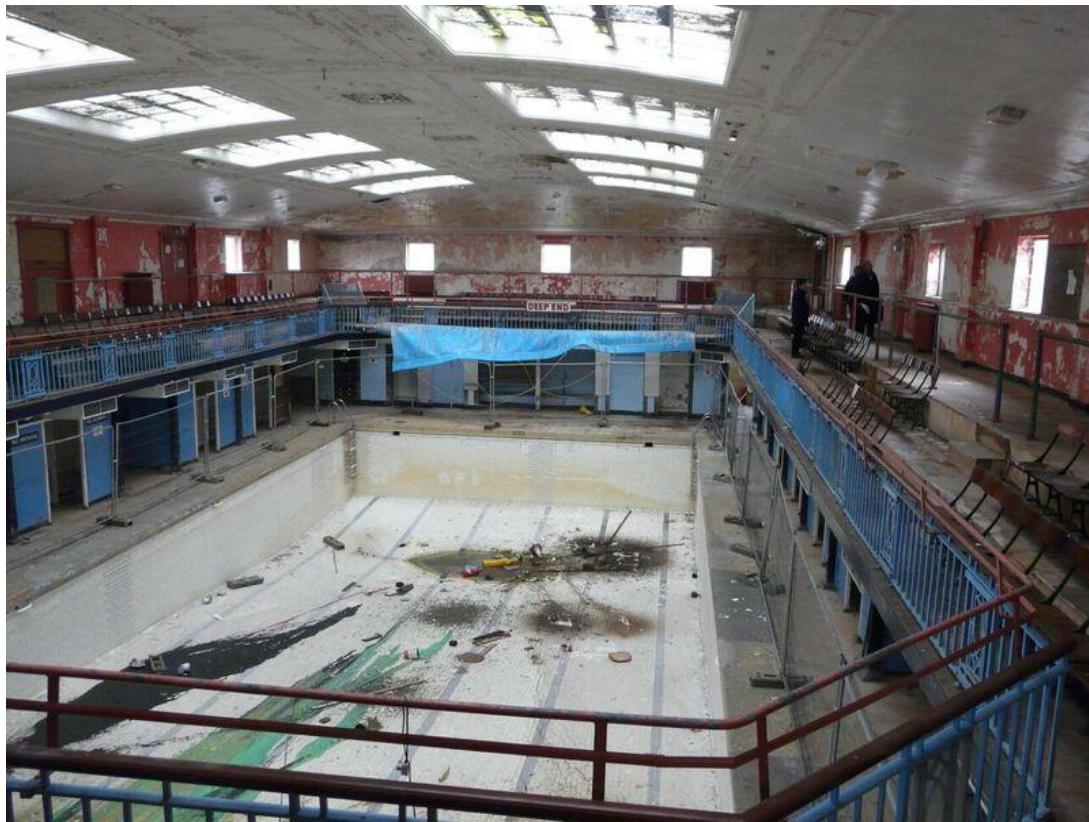
GROUND FLOOR PLAN
2537.0 M SQ



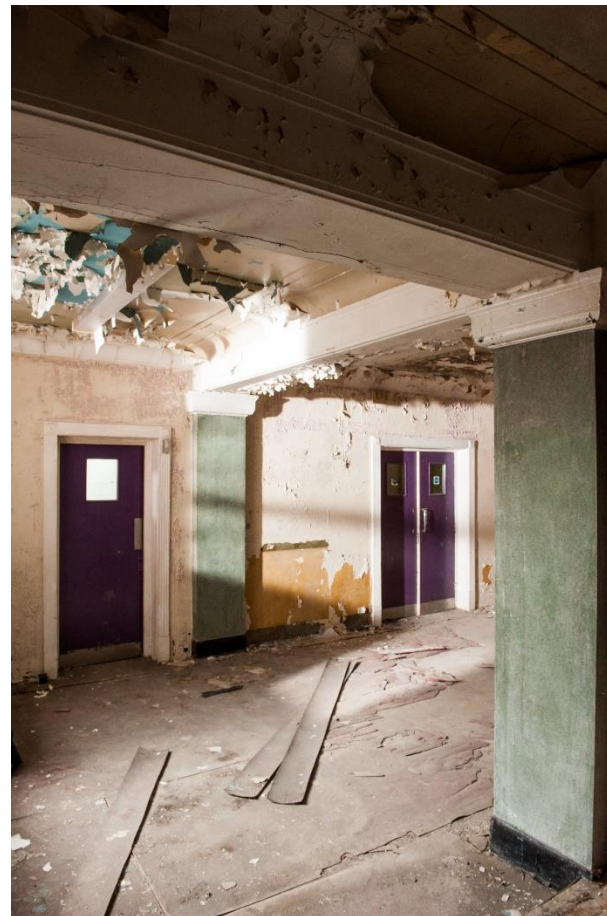

- A new cafe

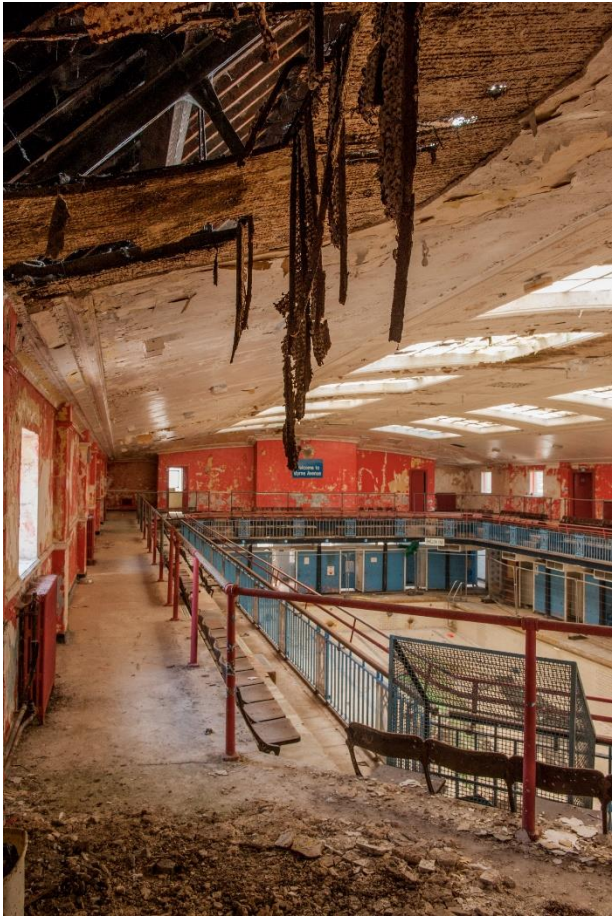
