- They can introduce you to a topic, or provide a steppingstone to a professional qualification, or offer a useful refresher to help you update your skills.

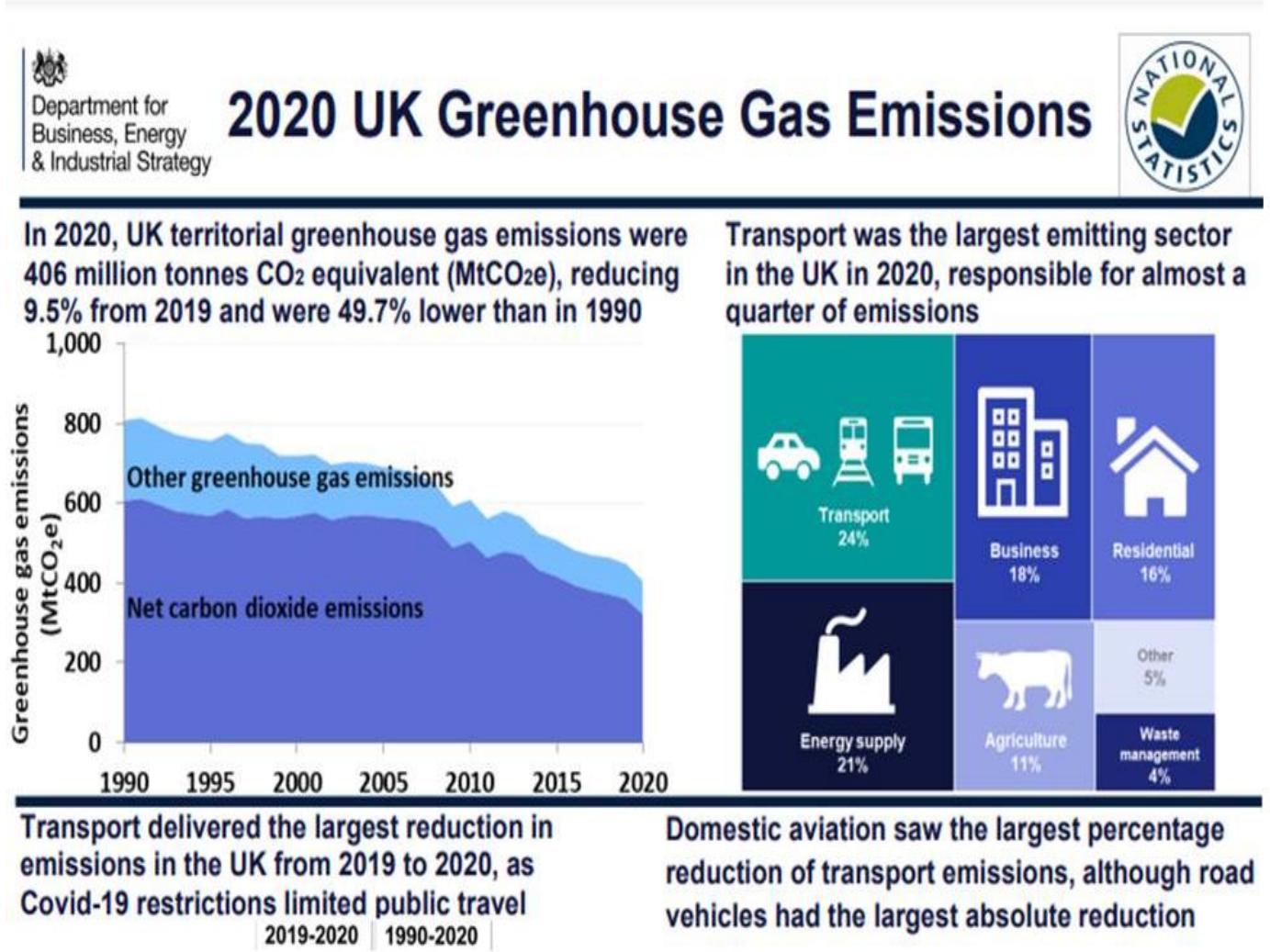
# Carbon Literacy Training
