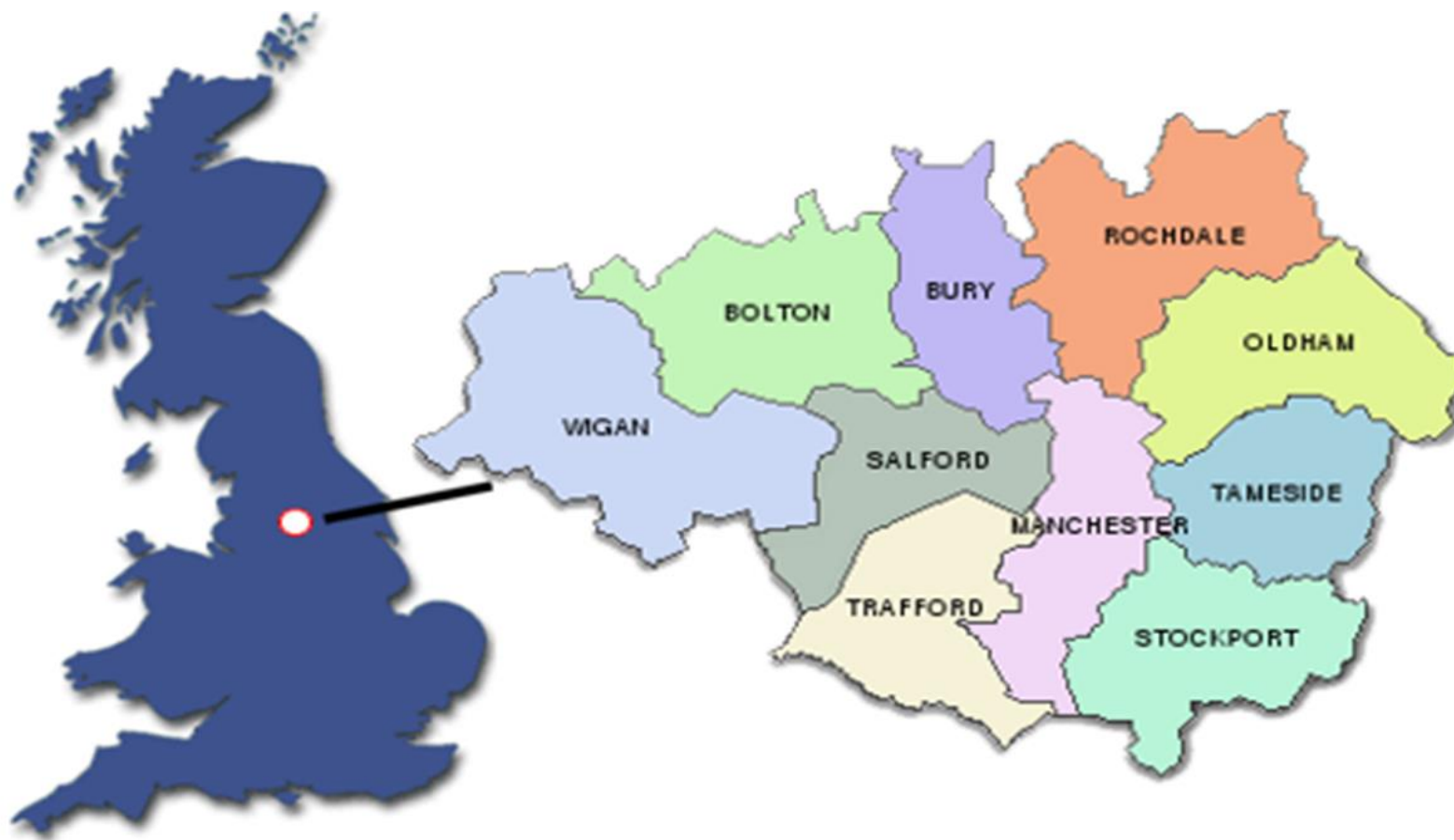

- 9th largest metropolitan authority:

Wigan Council – Asset Management

- Engaged with our elected members to develop Asset Management Policy, Strategy, Plan, Service Standards
- Whole Life Costing / Life Cycle Planning
- Supporting Invest To Save (£16.9m) across all services
- Past DfT Challenge and Flood Recovery Funds (£5.7m)
- Current DfT Challenge fund bids (£7.8m)
- Innovation in I.T, materials and processes

Wigan Council – A580 East Lancashire Road

As a result of working together we were able to:

- Reduce number of road closures from 10 to 4
- Reduced CO₂, driver hours, fuel and traffic movements by 50%
- Increase volume of planed/laid materials laid per shift
- Increase area of resurfacing whilst keeping within budget
- APSE 2019 Innovation Finalist

Other Projects

- Street Lighting - @£1m savings pa
 - 36,500 LED lighting units installed
 - 3,500 LED traffic lighting units installed
 - 1,050 solar or non-illuminated bollards installed
 - 60% energy reduction / 3,400 tones of CO₂ saved
- Winter Maintenance - @£300k pa savings
 - Invested in Salt Barn
 - Coated Salt
 - New fleet
 - Route Optimisation (less routes)
 - Winter Sensor trials
- Highway Structures
 - Innovative method of waterproofing
 - Reduced cost by @60%
