1. Welcome and Introductions

4. Training Modules/Opportunities & Modern Apprenticeship in Sustainable Resource Management: Fiona Craig, Training Advisor, ZWS

Fiona Craig gave a detailed presentation and talk relating to the above. The talk highlighted the newest information regarding the SWITCH forum and its various priorities. Fiona then introduced 2 apprentices from Glasgow City Council to provide the group with their thoughts and experiences so far within their apprenticeships. Finally Billy Kenny, Training Coordinator, Glasgow City Council provided information on their cleansing apprenticeship scheme. Information was provided on how Glasgow City Council promotes the apprenticeship schemes.

5. The Household Recycling Charter and Code of Practice: Lorna Richardson, Policy Manager, COSLA & Andy Dick, Programme Manager, ZWS

Lorna Richardson and Andy Dick provided an informative presentation on the Household Recycling Charter and Code of Practice. The presentation included information on the Zero Waste Taskforce and the reasons behind the introduction of the Charter. The group were also provided information on the Code of Practice which including information on the main areas of the Charter, a brief overview of the chapters including key points on operations. Following the presentation Lorna and Andy answered a number of questions surrounding this issue including funding, the brokerage and information on transition plans.
