



- Increases in flood risk
- Coastal change
- Damage to buildings and infrastructure
- Increased prevalence of pests and diseases in the natural environment





Scotland: Setting an Example

- Put up £2 million for the loss and damage fund
- Launched a £55 million Nature Restoration Fund
- Announced proposals to more than double Scotland's onshore wind capacity by 2030
- Committing over £100 million to advancing cleaner energy and make Scotland a leading hydrogen producer.





- Accreditation requirements leading to change






