



Bristol City Leap

- A joint venture company between Bristol City Council and Ameresco Ltd
- The council has let a **20-year Concession Contract** to Ameresco Ltd, to deliver and fund low carbon energy projects across the council's land and buildings
- Ameresco Ltd is BCC's pre-procured partner and has the right of first refusal, to deliver and fund all low carbon energy projects on the council's estate, including its social housing.
- Bristol City Leap works in collaboration with Services across the council, facilitated by
 a new City Leap Client Function in the council, to develop low carbon energy projects.
- These projects will need to meet pre-set Project Acceptance Criteria
 if they do so, they will be approved by the council



City Leap's Plans

Past and Future Investment £m



- Deliver a minimum capital investment of over £700m by 2028 and c.£1bn over the 20-year partnership.
- Make the council's own operations carbon neutral (Scope 1&2).
- Improve the energy efficiency of the council's social housing by 2030.
- Substantially expand the city's heat network and make it carbon neutral by 2030.
- Making a material reduction in the overall carbon emissions for Bristol



Co-benefits

- Create over 1,000 new jobs, apprenticeships and work placements
- 100% of people working on City Leap will be paid at least the Real Living Wage
- A further €1.35m of social value
- Create new Funds to invest in the city:
 - €3m Community Benefit Fund over the term of the Concession
 - €1.8m Community Energy Fund
 - €0.6m Research and Development fund
- Enable community investment into City Leap Projects 10% of capital requirement available to public subscription through a dedicated crowd funding platform excluding heat network.








Bristol Just Transition Declaration



- 1. Centring the expertise of disadvantaged communities at every step of the journey,
- 2. Good future-proof jobs for everyone,
- 3. Empowering disadvantaged communities to take climate and ecological action,
- 4. Supporting individual change through system change,
- 5. Fair distribution of costs and benefits,
- 6. Prioritising accessible communication,
- 7. Standing in solidarity with those experiencing the worst climate and ecological impacts across the globe,
- 8. Building inclusive resilience,
- 9. Infrastructure for all,
- 10. Embedding the process internally and at the beginning.
