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#### A new waste strategy

- Critical that consultation and full member engagement is carried out
- Key aspects:
  - Creation of Ansa Environmental Services Ltd
  - Move from landfill with new infrastructure
  - Introducing food waste collection
  - Reviewing household waste recycling centres



#### Alternative Service Delivery Vehicle Ansa

- Company created in 2014
- Over 350 staff transferred
- Continuing to deliver all services
- Now working with two other districts
- Delivered savings

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#### **Food waste collection**

- Challenge to introduce within tight budget
- Initial feasibility to collect food separately £2m a year additional revenue - rejected by cabinet
- Competitive dialogue
- IVC solution
- Introduction in autumn 2019



#### **New Waste Contracts**

Winning Bidder: Biowise Limited

- Design build and operate contract for 15 years' operation
- IVC plant being constructed on Cheshire East site outside Crewe





# Household waste and recycling centre changes

**Proposed changes** 

- Closing one site 60%
- Reducing hours at all sites 63%
- Charging for rubble/construction waste 55%
- Allowing small traders to use sites 68%



**Resources and waste strategy** 

**Consistency implications:** 

- Weekly, separate food
- Kerbside sort
- Multi-stream
