

An ABS is a firm providing reserved legal activities (and other legal or nonlegal services) where a non-lawyer

- is a manager of the firm, or
- has an ownership-type interest in the firm

A firm may also be an **ABS** where another body

- is a manager of the firm, or
- has an **ownership-type interest** in the firm
- and at least 10% of that body is controlled by non-lawyers.

Buckinghamshire Law Plus is a private limited company established in a joint venture between Buckinghamshire County Council and Buckinghamshire & Milton Keynes Fire Authority.

This is the first public sector enterprise to be granted a licence by the Solicitors Regulation Authority as an 'Alternative Business Structure' (ABS).


