ADVISORY GROUPS




- Each group has had 4 meetings over the course of the year


- Three service specific conferences



- New Performance Networks software database still under construction by CAMMS to make it easier to report and analyse data
- Market operations will be added as a new service area in 2017-18, developed in collaboration with NABMA
- Trading standards module has been rolled out on a UK-wide basis following a successful pilot
- Corporate services benchmarking is underway in Northern Ireland to meet the needs of Part 12 of the Local Government Act






- Working with a range of organisations nationally on benchmarking initiatives (Defra, Department for Communities and Local Government Litter Strategy meetings, Zero Waste Scotland, SCOTS)
- LAMS quality inspections for cemetery and crematoria grounds are launching soon. An App for LAMS is being developed using GIS location and photo evidence for inspections which eliminates manual input
- Process benchmarking projects still underway within the Scottish groups including: Building & Housing, Roads & Highways, Transport & Mechanical and Parks, Grounds & Streets
