Our speakers

Wayne Bexton, Director of Environment and Sustainability, Nottingham City Council

Wayne Bexton is the Director of Environment and Sustainability at Nottingham City Council and has worked in public sector energy and sustainability fields for over 15 years, having previously delivered sustainability advice in the private sector.

Wayne has been recognised as one of the top 500 influencers on environment and climate change, and is Chair of the D2N2 Low Carbon Board as well as being the Senior Responsible Officer for the Midlands Net Zero Hub.

Wayne has delivered numerous high profile, high value environmental projects and programmes for the public sector across the East Midlands, receiving industry recognition along the way including the National Lottery Awards Environment Category Winner, edie National Green Recovery 2021 and Local Authority of the Year 2020/2021.

Currently leading on Nottingham's ambitious energy, sustainability, waste and carbon neutral delivery programme, which is recognized as the leading local authority response to the climate emergency in the UK.

Professor Lucelia Rodrigues, University of Nottingham

Professor Lucelia Rodrigues is Chair of Sustainable and Resilient Cities in the Faculty of Engineering, University of Nottingham (UoN). Lucelia is a passionate, global leader in the resilience of communities and buildings in a changing climate, involved in several major sustainability projects focused on energy, carbon management and comfort.

She is Deputy Director of the University of Nottingham Energy Institute, and Founder and Director of Transport, Mobility & Cities @Nottingham, an initiative bringing colleagues from all faculties together to tackle the challenges our cities face working with industry, authorities and catapults. Prof Rodrigues also runs the MArch in Architecture and Sustainable Design masters programme.

She is the Head of Department of Architecture and Built Environment and the first female professor in the 178-year history of the department (Est. 1843 as Nottingham Government School of Design). Lucelia is also a member of the Buildings, Energy & Environment Research Group.

Steph Parker, Senior Advisor, Energy Systems Catapult

Stephanie Parker is a Senior Advisor at the Energy Systems Catapult. She works in the Complex Sites team helping predominantly public sector organisations deliver Net Zero. Most recently, Stephanie's work has focused on the Public Sector Decarbonisation Guidance, a free to access suite of guidance, tools and checklists that makes it simpler and quicker for the public sector to decarbonise their buildings and estates. Stephanie's background is in the Civil Service, where she worked on policy and strategy across a number of departments over ten plus years. Latterly she worked on decarbonising commercial and industrial buildings in the Department for Business Energy and Industrial Strategy, now the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero.

Tim Crawshaw, APSE Energy Associate

Timothy is a multi-disciplinary green urban development consultant with specific knowledge, skills and experience in energy, sustainable transport, green infrastructure, historic buildings, community development and public engagement. With over twenty years of experience in sustainable development he is also a facilitator, lecturer and trainer, with excellent interpersonal and communication skills. With both UK and international experience, he complements his core planning skills with an astute approach to funding and finance, project management and economic development. Timothy is Chair of the Tees Valley Nature Partnership working with multiple partners and stakeholders in delivering biodiversity net gain, health and wellbeing benefits, and supporting economic growth. He is a Chartered Member of the Royal Town Planning Institute, currently serving as Vice President.

Heather Stokes, Conservation Team Manager, Nottinghamshire County Council

Following a career change from the oil industry, via an MSc in Environmental and Ecological Sciences, I've worked in conservation in the north of England, Wales and the East Midlands for over 30 years. For the last 19 years I've worked for Nottinghamshire County Council, managing a team of conservation specialists covering archaeology, ecology, heritage tourism, historic buildings and the historic environment record. The team hosts Greenwood Community Forest and the Biodiversity Action Group and in 2018 took on the management of the County Council's Green Spaces (85 sites covering c. 1250ha). We also currently act as accountable body for two major projects – Miner2Major, a 5-year £3.8m landscape partnership project for Sherwood, and Trees for Climate, part of a DEFRA-funded woodland creation programme led by the Community Forests.

Nigel Hallam, Workplace Parking Levy Service Manager, Nottingham City Council

Nigel is the WPL Service Manager at Nottingham City Council. Nigel has been instrumental in the efficient operation of the multi award-winning WPL scheme.

Nigel developed the operational policy and procedure for Nottingham's WPL and continually refines the operational compliance and enforcement model to ensure successful compliance and licensing of employers.

Nigel has expertise in the identification of relevant WPL stakeholders. Additionally, he has invaluable knowledge, expertise and experience in the key messages and modes of engagement with stakeholders that are required to successfully operate a WPL scheme.
