

- Increased use of primary secondary school eg breakfast / holiday clubs
- Forensic cleaning



Comments on the future




- Work lost as a result of council building and office closures
- Schools opting for private contractors or taking the service in-house
- Across the board decreases as a result of budget cuts
- Reductions in specification / frequency / Service Level Agreements
- Reductions in staff



Key costs and productivity


PI 16 - Total square metres (excluding outdoor areas) cleaned per FTE employee





Starters and Leavers


PI 25a - Number of leavers per annum as percentage of workforce





Starters and Leavers


PI 21a - Number of starters per annum as percentage of workforce

Key Findings

- Drive towards re-negotiating SLAs/contracts
- Move towards 'output' specifications
- Underlying trend remains positive
- Labour costs remain a key driver in the delivery of services



Other key findings

 Cost per square metre cleaned has continued to climb:-

2012-12 £12.36

2016-17 £15.05

Increase of 3.6% in areas cleaned

Staff absence marginally up on last year by 1.67%
