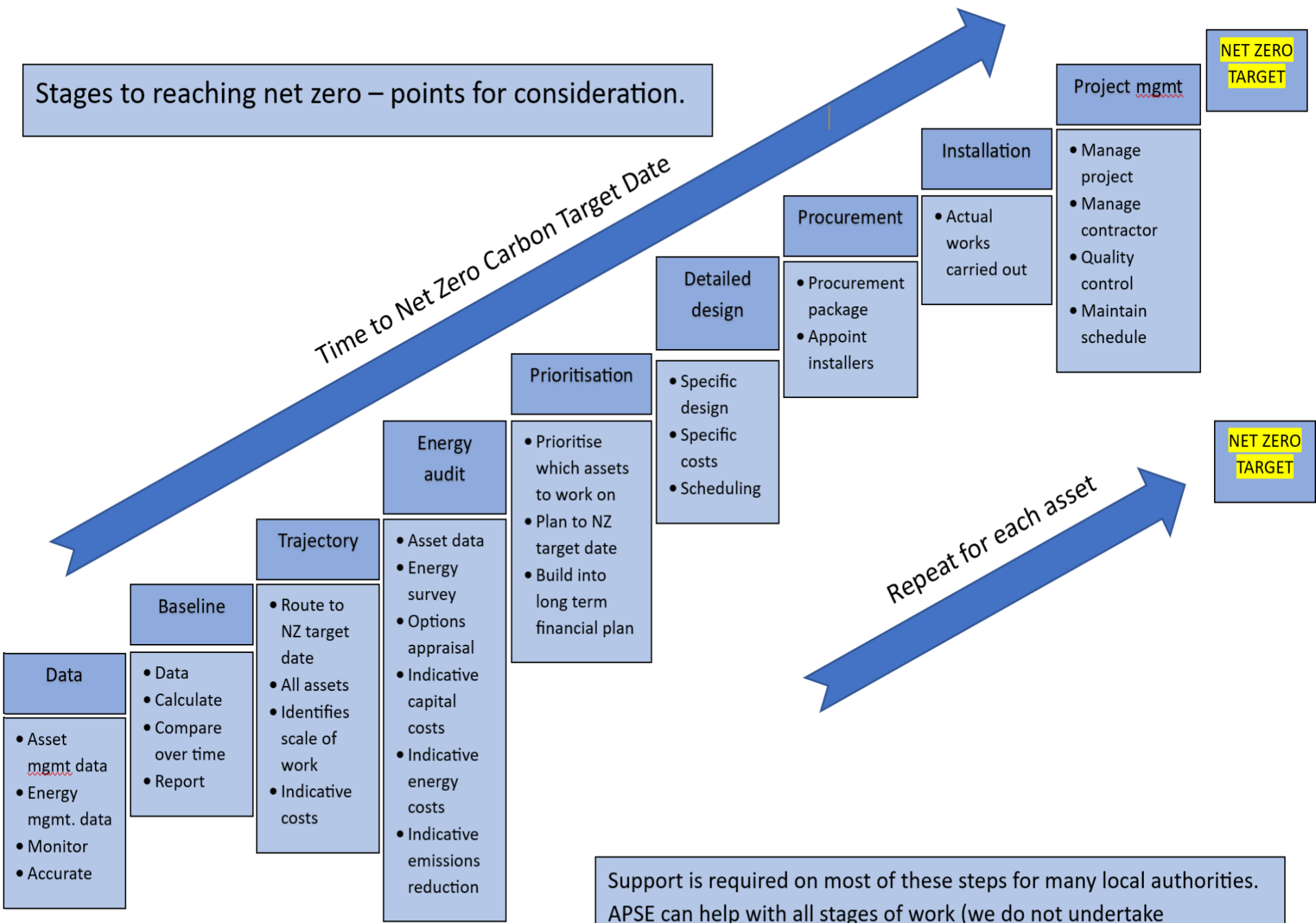
What is our message?
