Affordable Housing Supply Programme

"Making sure everyone in Scotland has access to good quality housing is a vital part of the Scottish Government's drive to secure economic growth, promote social justice, strengthen communities and tackle inequality."

Five Year Target to March 2016

- Deliver 30,000 additional affordable homes.
- Including 20,000 social homes, of which 5,000 will be council homes.
- Supported by £1.70 billion of SG funding over five years.

Progress

- 22,762 affordable homes delivered.
- 15,903 of these for social rent 80% of our social rent target.
- 3,700 council homes.

Council House Build Programme

The aim of the Council House Build Programme introduced in April 2009 – was to incentivise local authorities to begin building new homes –

- 2009-10 almost £50 million allocated to 23 councils to build 2,297 homes.
- In July 2010, an additional £30 million was allocated to build a further 1,001 homes.
- In September 2011, as part of the Innovation and Investment Fund, £35 million was allocated to local authorities to build a further 1,172 council homes.

Resource Planning for Councils

- 2012 a resource planning approach was adopted, by bringing together the council and Registered Social Landlord (RSL) funding streams into one budget for the first time.
- enabled each council to exercise its strategic role more flexibly, and to put forward to Government a programme of social and affordable housing developments, based on their Local Housing Strategy.

Funding 2015/16

- AHSP budget for 2015/16 is over £390m.
- £300m allocated to local authorities.
- Future Resources minimum resource planning assumption for the three years to March 2019.
