#### Involvement in CYP in co-design process

•Children and young people consultation workshops were delivered in each DEA during the co-design process (2015). A child rights based approach was used to design and deliver the workshops.

•Children's booklets were developed and circulated to schools, using story telling and pictures for feedback and inclusion in the plan;

•Consultation with young people took place in 2017 during the consultation of the draft community plan;

•Young people were involved in shaping the content of CYP video and featured within the video.

- 8 Local Growth Planning (LGP) areas: Ballyarnett, Foyleside, The Moor, Waterside, Strabane, Faughan, Sperrin, Derg.
- CYP feature in all 8 LGP. Local Growth Planning Governance structures will be responsible for progressing local needs under CYP theme. CYP will be represented in governance arrangements.
- Variety of Youth Participation options will be in place at local levels (Lets Talks Workshops, Youth Forums, Youth Clubs, Events etc).

#### Children and Young People have the best start in life

- Our children and young people are safer, healthier, more respected and included;
- Our children and young people are better able to fully realise their potential and become active, responsible citizens.
  - Adopt UNICEF UKs Child Rights Framework to improve services for CYP.
  - Support the implementation of Pioneering Community Pilot to address child maltreatment.
  - Deliver proactive early Intervention to improve family support for children falling below the statutory thresholds for intervention.
  - Provide positive opportunities for C&YP to take part in play, music, arts, drama, recreation and sport.
  - Engage and empower YP through their participation in the development of an inclusive programme of events and initiatives for Year of Youth 2019.
  - Establish local structures to allow CYP to be involved in decisions which affect them and have their voices heard, including establishment of a Youth Council.

- Young people will be at the heart of the approach.
- Unicef working group adults and young people will be represented.
- Mandatory badges: Culture, Cooperation & Leadership, Communication. 3 additional badges to be chosen locally.













**Community Planning Action**: Engage and empower YP through their participation in the development of an inclusive programme of events and initiatives for Year of Youth 2019.

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- Over 10,000 CYP consulted for the European Youth Capital bid. Five key themes identified;
  - Democracy
  - Education & Skills
  - Health & Wellbeing
  - Access & Inclusion
  - Cultural Programme.
- Funding for the programme including core Council funding, PEACE IV, Big Lottery and Arts Council NI. Other funding applications are live.
- The Branding for the project was developed by Ulster University students as part of the end of year project.

#### **Concluding comments**



- Putting young people at the heart of the community planning process will involve YP being involved at all layers;
  - shaping the strategic planning process
  - shaping programme design
  - co-designing the youth participation and democracy structures
  - involved and/ or leading programme delivery.
- Youth engagement can be resource intensive and expensive, ensure to identify an allocated budget and staffing with a suitable skillset to involve YP.
- Allow flexibility in programming, tailor the approach as you progress based on what the YP are telling you they want to see.
- Feedback to those involved and be explicit about how their feedback and views have shaped the programme.
- Capacity building and training is essential to ensure that all YP are given the opportunity to engage.
- Partnerships with the statutory, community, voluntary and private sector are essential for success (youth workers and creatives).
- Be open and willing to be challenged and empower young people to challenge constructively.
