






Current Challenges

- Scaling back of Work Programme
- Local government interest but lack of incentives

Multiple, reinforcing barriers

Local solution:

- Service integration
- Personalised support







Towards Local Provision



Challenges

- ➤ Lack of funding and increasing budget cuts (83.5%)
- > Fragmentation of services at central government level (62%)
- ➤ Difficulties partnering with other sectors (54.4%)
- > Fragmentation at local level (49.4%)
- Lack of data or information sharing opportunities (35.4%)



Towards Local Provision

- Powers have not gone far or fast enough
- Clear appetite for further devolution
- Appropriate mix of risks and rewards







Recommendations



NATIONAL LEVEL AND DEVOLUTION ASKS

- > Further Devolution
 - Youth unemployment
 - Long-term unemployment
- ➤ Integrate Jobcentre Plus with local authority services
- ➤ Create a National Learning Network / Data Sharing

LOCAL LEVEL

- ➤ Co-locate JCP with other public services
- ➤ Partnerships with neighbouring local authorities
- ➤ Develop Local Integration Boards
