


Energy Price Benchmarking

Why?

Cost up by 18%

Lots of time looking at alternative models

Energy usage down by 17%

Does anyone else do better?

1p saving on electricity and 0.25p on gas would yield £210k saving for the Council and around £185k for the others that we buy for.

What could we achieve?

Savings?

Every other site I have seen was paying 1p more for electricity and 0.5-1p more for gas

1p for electricity and 0.25p for gas is 10% of Southend's overall spend

Evidence that buying OK

Would imply that others are spending too much




Feels like a win-win piece of work

Southend Saves or gains comfort


