






# How it works





#### **Challenges to community energy**

> Messy/contradictory policies:

- FCA forcing existing co-operatives to change structure to bencom – cost and hassle to existing groups
- FCA don't expect investors to want a return on their investment
- HMRC changing tax relief rules EIS and SEIS ending with no clarity on replacement
- > Supportive policies:
- Schools & community groups do not need EPC of D+ and can pre-register for FITS could be a big benefit
- Rural Community Energy Fund and Urban Community Energy Fund

## Quantum

#### Local Authority role: Obstructive?

- Focus on own LA role (inward looking)
- Fails to see opportunity of supportive community
- Raises barriers e.g. leases, procurement rules, procedures
- Expects time/energy but does not provide benefit back to the community group
- NB these are volunteers, the LA could be another place to get stuck/waste valuable time
- Solutions to this: work on pilot projects or look at successful examples of LA-community energy
- Just get on with your own projects separately



### Local Authority role: Enabling

- Accessing potential project sites
  - Authority owned land
  - Public buildings
- Policy and publicity support
  - Identifying opportunities new developments
  - Involvement in renewable energy strategies
  - Planning support
- Financial partnerships
  - Shared investment & returns
- Reducing constraints



### Local Authority role: Enabling

#### Warrington Borough Council: Low Carbon Lymm

- Recognises role of community group
- Legal team did leases for PV on schools
- Use of WBC's PV supplier to get existing installer price
- Plymouth Council Plymouth Energy Co-op
  - Set up Plymouth Community Energy
  - Loaned £500,000 seed funding pre-share offer
  - Installing 20 PV schemes on schools
- Rochdale Borough Council
