
#### **Areas of Decrease**

- 75% repairs on new housing units through a Local Authority Housing Company
- 33.3% work from the insourced housing stock
- 8.33%- growth in new contracts with housing providers
- 25.00% work undertaken for the private rented sector


- 16.67% reduction in stock
