Formation of Local Enterprise Partnerships (2010)


City Deals, waves 1 & 2 (2012-14)

Heseltine publishes No Stone Unturned (July 2012) Local Growth Fund and Growth Deals (2013 onwards)

Devolution Deals (2014 onwards) 100% business rate retention (2018-20)

Devolution Deals Agreed





Progress to date:

- Seven deals agreed to date. Government has extended the Devolution Deal with Manchester and has agreed six further deals with Cornwall, Sheffield City Region, Tees Valley, North East, Merseyside City Region & the West Midlands
 - More than 20% of the population of England 11.6
 million people covered by deals agreed so far
 - Five out of the eight English Core Cities have agreed deals, with the rest in advanced discussions
- City Deals have been agreed in Devolved
 Administrations (Glasgow & Clyde Valley and Aberdeen)
- Royal Assent for Cities & Local Government Devolution
 Act
- Six new directly elected city region-wide mayors in May 2017 and two new Combined Authorities
