New and refurbished vehicles and a network of smaller, more appropriately-sized vehicles will improve the journey experience and attract more passengers.

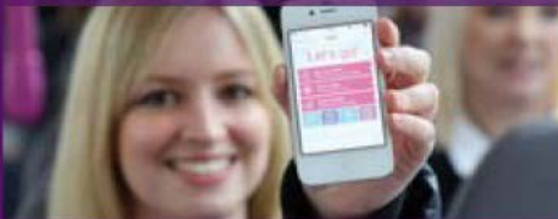
