

- Partnerships


















Organised Crime Groups

■ There are 117 (3.1%) active OCGs in 2023 involved in the waste sector





- of the 117 OCGs linked to the waste sector, 97% are engaged in criminality other than environmental crime.
- The most common forms of criminality were found to be drug activity,
- specialist money laundering and violent crime.
