What is an asset?

Buildings, vehicles, plant, equipment - decarbonising
People – training to think differently
Capacity – expand and enhance it
Partnerships and engagement
Other organisation's assets – near and far

Draught strips; pipe insulation; LEDs; movement sensors - routine maintenance

Pool covers; bigger LED projects; solar PV – short term payback

Meters; readings; BMS settings
