Prevent

- 2.4 million tachographs checked
- 113,934 roadside encounters
- 12,894 search app encounters
- 5,827 pieces of intel actioned
- 7,886 pieces of intel converted to cases
- 11,058 cases processed in the Remote Enforcement Office
- 391 REO desk based assessments completed





Respond

- 38 tachograph fraud devices found
- 27,101 prohibitions issued for all defects and offences
- 2,872 overload prohibitions issued
- 310 serious investigations cases open
- 10,402 fixed penalties issued for 14,501 offences
- Over £3million taken in fines at roadside
- 24 vehicles impounded
- 15,148 requests for ANPR data

What we found:

- Using false numberplates
- Serious brakes defects
- No tachograph record in use
- Suspected speed limiter manipulation device
- No Vehicle Exercise Duty for over 12 months
