DEVELOPING A BESPOKE CCTV SOLUTION TO PREVENT FLY-TIPPING

THE WAKEFIELD EXPERIENCE

OBJECTIVE

fly-tipping and anti-social behaviour throughout Wakefield were becoming a concern to our district. Not only were thy damaging the environment and posing a threat to both residents and wildlife, they were also costing the taxpayer.

Poor surveillance was allowing people to dump their waste illegally - instead of using an alternative method such as kerbside collection. It was also allowing anti-social behaviour throughout the district to go undetected.

Our goal was therefore to develop an overt rapid deployable CCTV camera - in collaboration with Mytec, our CCTV maintenance supplier.

ASSESSING THE SCALE OF THE PROBLEM RESOURCES

In 2019-2020 Wakefield Council received 2,626 reports of fly-tipping. 45% of calls received directly to the Enforcement team were regarding fly-tipping.



x6 Enforcement Officers attending on average 50 jobs per week meaning resources were overstretched.

ASSESSING THE SCALE OF THE PROBLEM LOGISTICS

Jobs are geographically allocated - 21 ward areas Rural aspect of the district - could be 14 miles from one job to another . This also makes it impossible for proactive work



Only 24 hours to collect evidence

ASSESSING THE SCALE OF THE PROBLEM FINANCIAL



Reports were generating 1071 tonnes of fly-tipping per year. This was costing in excess of 200k.

ASSESSING THE SCALE OF THE PROBLEM CONFIDENCE

Hard to keep on top of calls when they are at such volume. 2

No proactive work undertaken.



Staff and residents disillusioned with the results.

DEVELOPING AN INNOVATIVE CCTV SOLUTION

An existing re-deployable solution provided by previous contractor Request for Mytec to relocate the camera we had

Mytec refused that the camera wasn't fit for purpose

Poor image quality, no alerts. Time consuming and costly to get mains power installed

BACK TO THE DRAWING BOARD

Market research in collaboration with Mytec

What else was out there?

Options were costly, time consuming and would put added pressure on the workforce

Mytec suggested they had capacity to build a re-deployable system which would link straight back to our control room.

DEVELOPING AN INNOVATIVE CCTV SOLUTION



Trialled the camera from Mytec in a fly-tipping hotspot

This allowed us to review 31 days of footage

Picture quality improved



Significantly cheaper, as connector was able to link directly to the street lights

SUCCESSES



Significantly more cost effective - previous CCTV solutions were £6,000. The new solution cost £3,800.

Increase in quality of images

CCTV was capturing more evidence meaning more fixed penalty notices were issued and paid.

Evidence from CCTV also resulted in a guilty verdict at court - 80 hours community service.

CCTV solution provided evidence of 9 youths causing ASB. The youths were identified and ASB caseworkers and WYP got involved in the area.

Elderly couple who were experiencing harrassment in their home from youths were able to move back and feel safe in their home due to cameras targeting their property.

The trial was so successful that we purchased an additional 8 units to help prevent and deter both ASB and fly-tipping in Wakefield.

Ability to further develop the units in areas with litter or no 3G or 4G coverage.



Reduced the need for witness statements and members of the public needing to atteend court.


The deployability of the cameras has enabled us to react to more reports over a flexible period of time.

It as resulted in us being more customer focussed.


Most importantly, Wakefield Council has seen a
