





Neighbourhood parks that are well designed, programmed and marketed present an opportunity to address public health challenges.

City Parks Alliance is the only independent, nationwide membership organization solely dedicated to urban parks in the USA. The organisation was established in 2000 by a nationwide group of urban parks administrators and advocates as an outgrowth of the Lila Wallace-Reader's Digest Fund's Urban Parks Initiative in the 1990s. Early workshops and conferences focused on partnerships, advocacy, and recreation.




