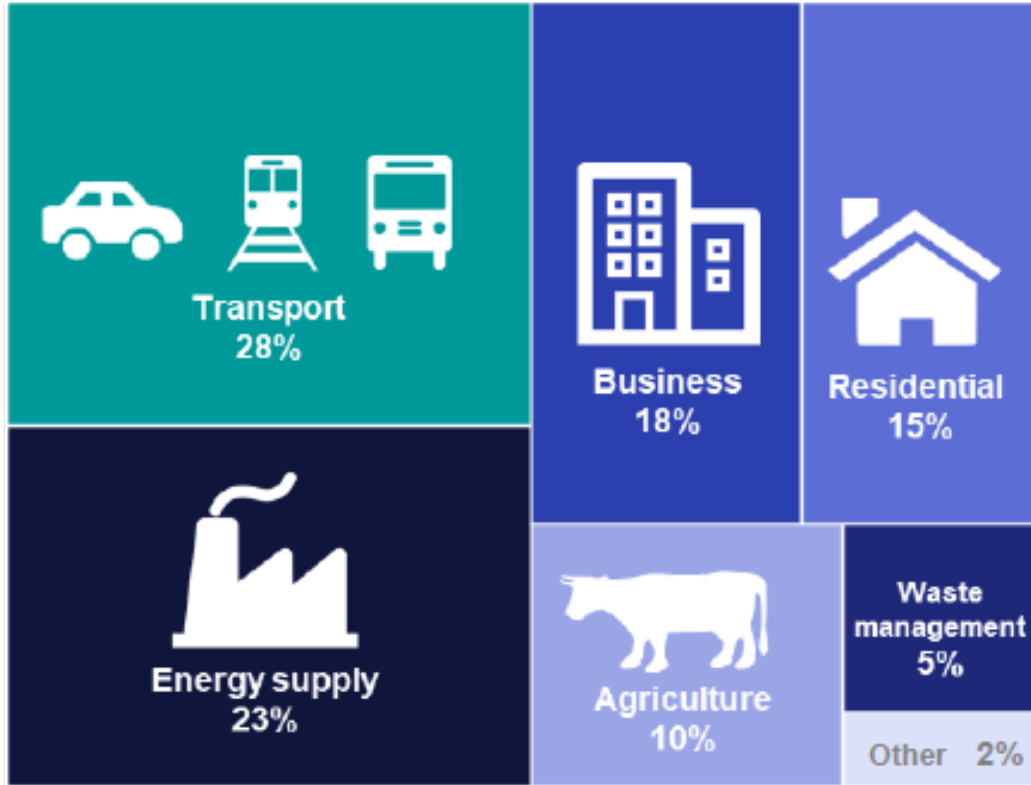

**Public Baths.** The Tuttle Street Swimming Baths were the first indoor swimming baths in Wrexham and opened in 1901. Built by Wrexham Borough Council, they remained in operation until 1970. At the time of opening, the baths were considered state-of-the-art and were heated using the next door incinerator. The baths have now been demolished.. (Contributed by **Peter Chadwick**).

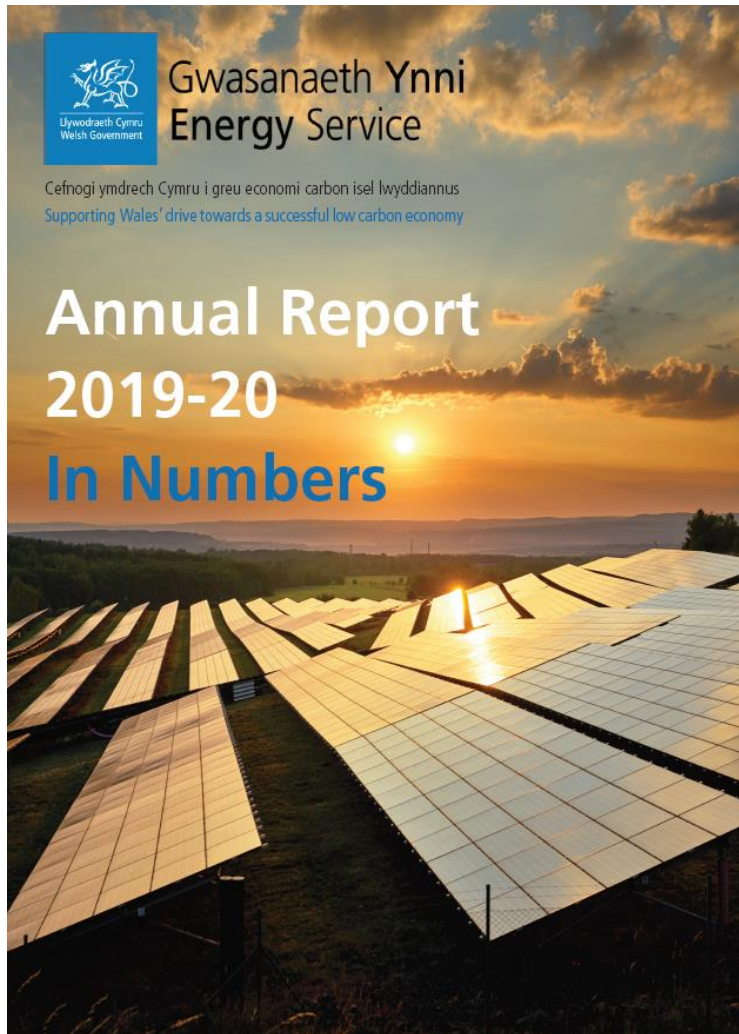
