


## Expected growth in the next 12 months










#### PI 01 Primary school (LEA) pupil meal prices (average highest price)






#### PI 01 Secondary school pupil meal prices (average price)






#### PI 36e All meal uptake (primary & special schools)








#### PI 36d All meal uptake (secondary schools)


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
#### PI 17a Food only cost per lunchtime meal (primary & special schools)








#### PI 11c Total cost per lunchtime meal - Primary & Special (exc. CEC)






#### PI 13 Primary school lunchtime meals served per staff hour






#### PI 20 Unit staff cost ratio (secondary schools)




















PI 20a - Staff absence (front line staff)






PI 25a - Leavers as percentage of total operational staff PI 25b - Leavers (employed for at least 12 weeks) as a percentage of total
