

### London Safer Lorry Scheme




- The Mayor of London and Transport for London commitment to making London roads safer
- Scheme ensure lorries entering London are fitted with basic safety equipment
- Runs 24/7 across London coming into force I
   September 2015
- Within LEZ zone

#### London Safer Lorry Scheme



- Under the scheme vehicles over 3.5t gvw;
  - Will be fitted with Class V and Class VI mirrors
  - And sideguards

#### Driver walk around checks

Vehicles used on the road MUST be in a roadworthy condition

All operators must have system and procedures in place to ensure compliance

Operator Licence undertakings were signed to agree to this



#### **The Operator Undertakings**

The licensed operator, UNDERTAKES to make proper arrangements so that:

The laws relating to the driving and operation of vehicles used under this licence are observed

The rules on drivers' hours and tachographs are observed, proper records are kept and that these are made available on request.

Vehicles and trailers are not overloaded:

Vehicles operate within speed limits;

Vehicles and trailers, including hired vehicles and trailers, are kept in a fit and serviceable condition;

Drivers report promptly any defects or symptoms of defects that could prevent the safe operation of vehicles and/or trailers, and that any defects are recorded in writing;

Records are kept (for 15 months) of all driver reports which record defects, all safety inspections, routine maintenance and repairs to vehicles, and that these are made available on request;

In respect of each operating centre specified, that the number of vehicles and the number of trailers kept there will not exceed the maximum numbers authorised at each operating centre (which will be noted on the licence);

An unauthorised operating centre is not used in any traffic area;

Furthermore, I will notify the Traffic Commissioner of any convictions against myself, or the company, business partner(s), the company directors, nominated transport manager/s named in this application, or employees or agents of the applicant for this licence and, if the licence is issued, convictions against the licence holder or employees or agents of the licence holder; I will, ensure that the Traffic Commissioner is notified within 28 days of any other changes, for example a change to the proposed maintenance arrangements; a change in the financial status of the licence holder [eg if placed in liquidation or receivership], or a change to Limited Company status or partnership, that might affect the licence, if issued.

I understand that the above undertakings will be recorded on the licence. Failure to comply with the conditions or undertakings recorded on the licence may result in the licence being revoked, suspended or curtailed. Failure to comply with conditions is a criminal offence.



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The check sheet is the drivers' proof that the vehicle was in a roadworthy condition at the start of the journey

#### Most Serious Infringements (MSI)

Seven MSI in all known as the seven deadly sins Five act as triggers for OCRS 'straight to red' these are;

- Exceeding weekly/fortnightly drivers hours by >25%
- No tachograph or speed limiter, tampering or false records
- Transporting dangerous goods without being identified as dangerous or appropriate containment
- Driving with someone else's driver card or card obtained with false documents or declarations
- Exceeding daily driving period by >50% without break



#### Operator licensing and MSIs

All seven MSI may affect the operator licence

#### Five as per OCRS plus

- Driving without valid roadworthiness certificate or serious defect
- Driving without valid driving licence

#### Could lead to loss of repute
