

### The legislation





### The legislation



10 hours driving 45 minutes break 4.5 hours driving 15 minutes break 6 hours work hours rest 48 hours average 17 weeks reference period 11 hours duty night shift limit 9 hours work 11 hours rest periods of availability tachograph extended driving reduced rest fortnightly driving logbook





Rule	EU Drivers Hours	GB Domestic Drivers Hours
Daily driving limit	9hrs extendable to 10hrs twice a week	10hrs in any working day (24hrs from start)
Breaks from driving	45mins after 4.5hrs driving (15mins + 30mins)	
Daily duty		11hrs in any working day
Daily rest	11hrs, can be reduced to minimum of 9hrs 3 time between weekly rests	
Weekly driving limit	56hrs	
Weekly rest	45hrs regular, reduced down to 24hrs	


# EU Drivers Hours vs. Working Time




Drivers hours rules Regulation (EC) 561/2006	Working time rules Directive 2002/15/EC
<ul> <li>Driving</li> <li>9hrs daily limit (10hrs twice a week)</li> <li>Max. 56hrs weekly driving</li> <li>Max. 90hrs fortnightly driving</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Working time (driving + other work)</li> <li>48hrs average per week no opt out</li> <li>Max. 60hrs working time in any one week</li> <li>Max. 10hrs night work (can be extended under agreement)</li> </ul>
<ul><li>Breaks</li><li>45mins after 4.5hrs driving</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Breaks</li> <li>EU drivers hours breaks take precedent</li> <li>30mins after 6hrs working</li> <li>45mins after 9hrs working</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Rest</li> <li>11hrs daily rest (split to 3+9 or reduced to 9)</li> <li>45hrs weekly rest (reduced to 24)</li> </ul>	<ul><li>Rest</li><li>As per EU drivers hours rule</li></ul>


#### Example of Working Time breaks




#### Example of EU driver hours breaks

#### Example of working time break



Driver may breach EU drivers hours to reach a suitable stopping place

 To ensure safety of persons, the vehicle or load, provided

-Road safety is not put at risk



GB domestic drivers hours rules may be relaxed where immediate action is needed to avoid

Danger to the life of people or animals
 Serious interruption to essential public services, telecommunications, postal services or use of roads, railways, ports or airports

-Serious damage to property
