The origin of BNG

- Previously an optional requirement until the Environment Act was passed in 2021.
- It does not change existing legal protections for important habitats and wildlife species.





What does this mean and why is this important?

 All planning permissions granted in England will have to deliver at least 10% biodiversity net gain

 Will become a mandatory requirement in November 2023












What we have done so far?
