The Issues

Cost - Fuel, Maintenance, Vehicle Value

Risk – More Miles = More Risk

Efficiency – Business Case or Custom and Practice

Corporate Image – Public Perception

Equity – Not available to all

HMRC – Different Rules for Cars and Vans!!



York's Issues

No Policy – Different practices across departments

High Home to Work Mileage – Small area but employees travel from far and wide

Resistance From Employees – Most saw it as their right.

Implied Term and Condition – Need to negotiate Not Consult



The Process

Set Up Negotiating Group — Council and Unions

Gather Data - Mileage, Costs, Service Impact

Interview Staff – Service Managers and Employees

Agree Data – Before Proposing any Charge!!!

Agree A Solution — Before Proposing any Charge!!!



York's Solution

New Council Wide Policy – And Collective Agreement from April 2013

Different Arrangements For Cars and Vans – But the Charge is the Same

Flexibility – No Charge Inside Council Area -Where the Journey is Supported by a Business Case. Only the Employee 'Benefit' is Charged For. 'One Off's' Not Subject To Charge.

York's Solution - The Impact

Equitable And Fair — Applicable to All Employees

No Change For Some – Van Drivers Continue to Commute For Free – Unless They Move!!

Reduced Home To Work Mileage — No Cars Being Taken Home Except for 'One Off's'

Auditable – Much Easier to Check Compliance. More responsibility and Accountability.

Defendable – Keeps Press and Public 'At Bay'
