The intention of the seminar is to inform corporate and service managers about their responsibilities in terms of health, safety and wellbeing, to provide an update about developments across the sector and highlight a number of case studies. Speakers include Jonathan Cowlan from Pinsent Masons discussing what councils need to have in place to deal with accidents and Dr Margaret Cunningham from the University of Stirling talking about stress and its impacts across an organisation.
