- Tackle 2-3 major investigations
- Complex investigations
- Governance Group oversight
- Serious and Serial offenders

What have we Delivered?

- 9 Major Investigations
- Joint working with Science, Legal and Operations

- 20,000+ tonnes of waste removed
- 4 Companies ceased operating
