- Out of date information on assets at flats
- Previously we'd have run this as a separate project.
- Decided to integrate with in-cab processes
 - Digitise the workflows rather than manual
 - Information input directly into ipad
 - Audit updates the asset register
 - Automatically arrange bins to be change

Bulky Waste





- Deal Our People Our Place Our Future Council
- Old system generated Paper worksheet
- Crew would manually sort route order
- University Students used to digitise the system
- Residents time booking bulky reduced 50%
- Route optimisation reduced fuel by 15%
- Increase in number of daily collection up 32%

Digital Accounts



- Deci Our People Our Place Our Future Council
- All waste crews have individual email
- They can access via mobile, own laptop or at depot
- They complete timesheets, update personal info, and book holiday request on-line

Resident training package



Which bin?

Each bin has certain waste that it is intended for. If you mix the contents of your bins, they become contaminated and will not be collected. It's important you place the correct items in each bin so you can avoid this happening.

- Started with really small amounts and built up slowly

- Sporting equipment to a male well-being group to help them become more active
- Computer equipment to local computer museum



- Providing sewing machines to local sewing groups
- Providing items to decorate school classrooms
- Items for upcycling groups

- 'Bag Splitting' area performing well (70%)
- Looked Unsightly
- At least it was re-using old Covid barriers and bins
- Challenged the Re-use Champions on the sites to come up with some ideas

- Repurposed items to fit in with Re-use theme
- Showed off the passion and creativity of the staff
- Wanted it to be a focal point but not tacky
- Wanted it to be practical and not just for show, but also a little quirky
- It has gone down well with residents
- Debunked the "myth" that staff get income from reuse by making it look more 'official'
- Extending this to all sites

- Enhanced with Second Chance saloon and underwater theme rooms – All using repurposed items
- Enhanced by the network of CIC's and Charities that have worked with us
- Great to see children making things from salvaged items
