



It is important that active traffic schemes such as cycling or walking are implemented correctly along suitable routes for short journeys or as part of a longer journey.















































## Safer Parking Scheme - Park Mark Award.

- Launched 20 years ago it is a national crime (and fear of crime) prevention initiative aimed at reducing criminal opportunity within car parking facilities.
- There are currently over 4500 accredited sites across the UK.
- The scheme is owned by Police Crime Prevention Initiatives and is managed by police assessors (Designing Out Crime Officers ) in partnership with our area manager team.
- A Park Mark assessment survey will include a site inspection of the car park. Award criteria include: general design features, lighting, surveillance opportunities, cleanliness, general management practices and analysis of Police crime and ASB statistics.


