




A heritage site

Lord Francis Egerton (1800-1857). Later 1st Earl of Ellesmere

Duke of Bridgewater

Garden's heyday from 1840s – WWI.


1920 Earls of Ellesmere sold Worsley New Hall to Manchester businessmen.

William Upjohn H.G. for 40 years retired in 1910 but lived in Gardener's Cottage until 1939.

Walled Garden hub of food and flower production 1920.

After sale of the estate became a Nursery.







The heyday



1948 Worsley New Hall demolished. Scrap sold for £2,500.

Nuclear bunker built! Latterly an illicit rave den!!

Middle Wood became a scout camp.

Worsley Nursery developed into a garden centre.

Angling Club on lake.

Meadows continued as agricultural tenancies.

General lack of investment and care.






