



Purpose:

Why the bee?


Bees and local parks deliver proven significant benefits to our ecosystems and yet both, currently, are in real danger and in need of our support more than ever.



"Little to no evidence of a muchneeded cash injection into parks from central government funding".


"Inflationary pressures mean the cost of running services has increased; parks managers can therefore expect 'much less bang for our buck."









Do you have friends of parks groups?




8.1 Do you think the number of visitors to your formal parks during the past year has:

13.1 How are volunteers involved in the parks service? [Multiple choice]



Do you make specific provision for promoting biodiversity in parks and green spaces?






Weed Control

Are you considering reducing the amount of chemical treatment you use to eradicate weeds?




11.1 What alternative methods will you be using to remove weeds? [Multiple choice]
