# 1. Welcome from Chair of the Advisory Group

Norman Hampshire from East Lothian Council welcomed the group to the National Mining Museum and thanked those in attendance.

# 2. Attendance and Apologies

# 3. Minutes of Previous Meeting (1 March 2017)

Those at the meeting agreed that the minutes were a true and accurate record.

#### 4. Matters arising

Stuart Pryde informed the group that we had received contact from Humza Yousaf MSP in regards to the issue of litter maintenance on trunk roads, and that Transport Scotland have been asked to meet with APSE. Garry Lee has made contact with Transport Scotland, and will arrange a meeting with the advisory group's small working group in due course.

#### 5. Community Empowerment Act Part 9 Allotments plus Q&A

Robin MacLean from Scottish Government attended to give an overview of Part 9 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015 on Allotments. Robin began by giving an overview of the sections of the 2015/16 Programme for Government that related to allotments stating that "growing your own food, including on an allotment or community growing space is an important part of Scotland's aim to become a Good Food Nation. For that reason we included in the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act provisions which bring allotments legislation up-to-date and enables communities to take over assets and buy land for Grow Your Own Food initiatives". The Act provides a legal framework that will promote and encourage community empowerment and participation, by creating new rights for community bodies and placing new duties on public authorities.

Part 9 updates and simplifies allotments legislation, by bringing it together in a single instrument. It introduces 6 new duties on local authorities to increase transparency on the actions taken by local authorities to provide allotments in their area and limit waiting times for an allotment.

It provides a clear definition of an allotment, shows that requests to lease an allotment are not treated as granted if the allotment is smaller than 250msq unless a smaller size is requested and agreed, provides a duty to take reasonable steps to provide allotments and to keep waiting lists at less than half the number of allotments the local authority has. It also provides a duty to prepare and review a Food Growing Strategy replacing plans for allotment provision which are currently set out in a LAs Open Space Strategy.

Questions were asked about compensation for the loss of crops, how to manage waiting lists, availability of land and of ruling out pieces of land that wouldn't provide value for money to the Council through economies of scale.

# 6. Member feedback on any other managers' forums / focus group

**Scottish Bereavement Benchmarking Group** – there are ongoing discussions about the Coffin Handling Charter and the need to apply a Scotland wide standard to coffin handling. East Ayrshire also took the lead on funeral poverty and introduced a range of low cost packages which were well received by residents.

**LEAMS Forum** – attendees were reminded that the next meeting of this forum was due next week.

**Commercialisation advisory group** – the Chair requested an update on APSE Scotland's Commercialisation advisory group meetings.

#### 7. Litter Action Plans discussion

There was also a short discussion around Litter Action Plans that was carried over into the Litter Managers Network meeting in the afternoon.

#### 8. Recent network queries and discussions

There was a discussion on a recent network query on Muslim burials, with various local authorities sharing their knowledge and arrangements.

#### 9. APSE update

Garry Lee provided an update on the current work of the Association, including the latest briefings, the recent APSE Scotland publication 'Doing local politics in Scotland', the APSE/ITN 'Redefining Neighbourhoods' programme, recent advocacy work, network queries, deadlines for Performance Networks data returns, upcoming APSE Energy and APSE Training events in Scotland, the work of APSE Solutions and upcoming Scottish and National seminars.
