3 x weekly refuse and dry recycling – The logic

- Reductions in residual waste capacity will stimulate recycling*
- Increases in food waste frequency will increase food waste capture**
- Widened the gap between food and refuse collections (Public fears)
- 3 x weekly frequency requires more consideration
- Avoided £1.6m Capital expenditure on new 140 litre bins
- Leaves room for additional reductions in residual waste capacity 180 Litres?
- Single stream collections for dry recyclables No splitters!

- 1. Bin snatch back 7,000+ bins removed!
- Public consultation
- 3. Canvass talk to as many people as possible
- 4. Staff and stakeholder briefings
- 5. Full information pack to all households
- 6. Ground Troops on every round every day
- 7. Call centre reinforcements
- 8. Website & Recycle App
- 9. Social Media campaign
- 10. Radio and press engagement

- Clear tag to request more liners






















Strategic priorities




Territory Management Team

- Weekly contaminated bin visits
- Participation monitoring and canvass
- Residual waste capacity control & audits
- Campaigns and events

- Tags for bins over 5% tolerance
- Recycling Officer visit to all 2nd offenders
- Regular feedback to crews on successes
- Regular crew 'Toolbox Talks'






Flats and communal bin strategy
