About the Seminar

The Forum is an ideal opportunity for officers, elected members and local authority partners and trade unions with an interest in street scene services and their development, particular in the areas of technology and performance management.

As traditional street services are now being amalgamated into larger service delivery units under the heading of 'street scene' there is now a greater need to justify costs and efficiency. The Forum will look at how the infrastructure of the service can be improved through route efficiency and in-cab technologies as well as looking at how cleanliness levels are monitored and thereby more intelligence–led cleansing programmes developed.

As well as the practical operational issues the speakers will look at how the need for behavioural programmes to address littering can be developed and monitored as to their effectiveness and looking how digitised monitoring systems are critical to this approach.

Consideration will also be given to the more troubling consideration of whether littering will ever be eradicated by looking at its origins, its global impact and whether by simply cleaning it away we will ever solve the problem.

Elected members who have a responsibility for overseeing the provision of street scene services and local environmental quality. Officers involved in street scene, community engagement, , planning and regeneration, health and wellbeing, housing, finance , human resources and IT.
