The meeting will commence at 10:00 for 10:30 and will include presentations and discussions on a number of topical issues, including, **HLF** talking about how the current funding mechanisms for The Parks for People programme will change as a result of the strategic funding review they are currently undertaking, and the forthcoming consultation which parks managers will be able to raise any comments they may have about these changes. **Newcastle-under-Lyme** will outline how they have created a network of supporters and volunteers which has led to significant sponsorship funding, budgetary savings and improved town centre cleanliness and horticultural features. **Kirklees** will outline the importance of having sites with community local value in order to develop greater public involvement. Coupled with this is the need to offer a wide range of appropriate opportunities and engaging projects for residents to sign up to. This work was recognized in the recent, APSE Environmental Innovation Awards, where Kirklees were amongst a select group of finalists. Finally there will be an in-depth analysis by APSE of how best to evaluate grounds maintenance service operational methodologies and working practices, as well as considering the ability to benchmark and performance manage services, leading to income generation opportunities. The advisory group is open to elected members, parks and grounds maintenance managers and professionals, performance and policy officers.
